Product overview

The **Giaccone Parka ACU UCP** is a windproof, water-repellent tactical parka designed for outdoor use, urban duty and military surplus applications; it suits users who need durable,



weather-resistant outerwear. This parka is also offered in a **Digital Camo ACU UCP** colorway (mod. ECWS) and includes a removable fleece liner for colder conditions.

Definition: a heavy-duty parka with a water-repellent H₂O membrane, sealed seams, a stowable helmet-capable hood and a detachable 450 g/m² fleece liner for added warmth.

Main features

Built for protection, comfort and practical use in tactical, duty or everyday outdoor scenarios.

- **Windproof & breathable:** H₂O water-repellent membrane for weather protection and moisture control.
- **Sealed seams:** Heat-bonded seam tape ensures strong water resistance.
- **Helmet-capable hood:** Zip-off hood that can be stowed in the collar and used over a helmet or cap.
- **Hands-free ventilation:** Underarm zip vents for adjustable airflow.
- **Secure storage:** Dual front zip pockets for documents, plus a left-sleeve pocket with internal pen holder and Velcro closure.
- **Removable fleece liner:** Approx. 450 g/m² grey-green fleece liner with elastic cuffs and two zip pockets on the hips.
- **Adjustable fit:** Velcro wrist cuffs and a tubular rank holder for professional use.

How to use / When it's useful

Use the parka as a weather shell in rainy or windy conditions and add the detachable fleece liner for cold-weather wear. The hood fits over helmets, making it suitable for tactical operations, duty work, hiking or daily commute in variable weather.

Quick answer: Wear the outer shell alone in wet or windy weather, and attach the fleece liner when you need extra warmth. In most cases, combine underarm vents and wrist adjustments to regulate body temperature without removing the jacket.

Care and notes

Follow the garment care label to preserve the membrane and sealed seams; proper care keeps the parka functional season after season.

- Follow washing instructions on the product label to protect the water-repellent membrane and sealed seams.
- Remove the fleece liner before washing the outer shell if recommended on the label.
- Close all zippers and Velcro fastenings before cleaning.
- Store dry and ventilated to avoid mildew on the liner.

FAQ



Q: Is the parka suitable for winter?

A: Yes. The detachable fleece liner (approx. 450 g/m²) provides an extra insulating layer that helps in cold conditions when combined with the outer shell.

Q: Can the hood fit over a helmet?

A: Yes. The hood is designed to be used over a helmet or cap and can be zipped off or stowed in the collar for convenience.

Q: Are the pockets waterproof?

A: The front pockets have zip closures that help keep items dry, and the outer shell is made with a water-repellent membrane and sealed seams to reduce water entry.

Q: Is the parka available in different sizes?

A: Yes. The parka is offered in multiple sizes; check the product size guide on the product page to choose the correct fit for tactical or everyday wear.

Q: Can I machine wash the parka?

A: Follow the care label instructions. Proper washing and drying methods are important to maintain the membrane and sealed seams—removing the liner before washing the shell may be recommended.

Q: What does "Digital Camo ACU UCP" mean for this parka?

A: It refers to the parka's digital camouflage color pattern (ACU UCP) used on the outer shell (model ECWS), designed for low-visibility urban/mixed environments.

Tip: Choose the right size and preferred color variant (plain or Digital Camo) before adding to cart; check the size guide and browse related tactical and duty outerwear for matching layers and accessories.
