Product overview

The Fregio Metallo Basco Cavalleria Fuori Corpo is a metal beret badge intended for personnel of the Esercito. It is a military badge that marks membership in the Cavalry branch and is suited for duty, ceremonial use, or verified collectors.



Definition: a 5.5 cm metal beret insignia depicting a grenade and trumpet with a seven-tongued flame over crossed lances inside a ring. The badge fits a standard beret and uses a rear prong attachment (piccaglia) for secure mounting.

Main features

Durable metal construction and historical Cavalry motifs make this insignia suitable for service use or certified collections.

- **Official design:** central grenade and trumpet, seven-tongued flame, crossed lances inside a ring.
- **Size:** 5.5 cm diameter, ideal for beret wear without bulk.
- **Material:** high-quality metal for long-lasting appearance.
- **Attachment:** rear prong (piccaglia) for firm, easy fitting to the beret.
- **Reserved sale:** available only to Esercito personnel or licensed collectors per law.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: attach the badge to the beret using the rear prong (piccaglia) so it sits flat and secure. In most cases, it is worn on service or ceremonial berets by authorized Esercito personnel.

The badge is also of interest to verified military collectors who hold the required prefettizia license (ex art. 28 TULPS). For purchases, send a copy of your military ID or indicate the barracks address as the delivery location during site registration.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the metal badge presentable and functional over time.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust; avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Store in a dry place to prevent tarnish or corrosion.
- Sale requires a copy of military ID or delivery to your barracks address.
- Collectors must provide the prefettizia license ex art. 28 TULPS to complete purchase.

FAQ

Q: Who can purchase the Fregio Metallo Basco Cavalleria Fuori Corpo?

A: Only Esercito military personnel with valid ID can purchase directly. Collectors may buy if they provide the prefettizia license ex art. 28 TULPS.

Q: What are the exact dimensions of the badge?



A: The badge measures 5.5 cm in diameter, designed to fit standard berets without being obtrusive.

Q: How is the badge attached to the beret?

A: It uses a rear prong attachment (piccaglia) for a secure fit. Push the prong through the beret fabric and fasten on the inside.

Q: Can a civilian buy this item without special paperwork?

A: No. Sale is restricted: civilians cannot buy it unless they are verified collectors with the required license.

Q: What material is the badge made from?

A: The badge is made of high-quality metal chosen for durability and a neat finish suitable for military use.

Q: What documentation is required for delivery?

A: You must provide a copy of your military ID or enter your barracks address as the delivery location during registration. Collectors must submit the prefettizia license ex art. 28 TULPS.
