Care and notes

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals.
- Keep dry and store in a padded box or display case to prevent scratches.
- Check the fastening before wearing to avoid loss; secure pin mechanisms if fitted.

A: The badge is made of metal with a brunito enamel finish, chosen for durability and a traditional appearance. The finish helps resist normal wear and keeps the design clear.

A: "Mai Strack" literally translates to "Never Tired" and refers to the regiment's resilience and commitment. The historical origin of the added "K" remains unclear and is part of its tradition.

A: The badge is suitable as an accessory on civilian outerwear, caps, or display pieces. If you intend to use it with official uniforms, follow your organization's regulations.
