The Metal Launch Director Badge (Brevetto Metallo Direttore di Lancio) is a metal insignia intended for military parachutists, veterans, and collectors of military surplus and tactical gear. It reproduces the Launch Director emblem and is suitable for wear or display where regulations allow.



**Definition:** A metal launch director badge is a burnished metal insignia that represents the qualification and role of a parachute launch director.

### Main features

Simple, durable construction with a recognizable parachutist motif and secure fasteners.

- **Distinctive design:** Two stylized wings topped by a parachute, with the cords converging at a central star.
- **Material:** Burnished metal for a durable finish that resists everyday wear.
- **Size:** 7.5 cm width x 3.5 cm height — compact and proportioned for uniforms or display.
- **Attachment:** Rear clamp fasteners for stable mounting and easy removal.
- **Use cases:** Suitable for display, collection, or wearing on uniforms when permitted by regulations.

### How to use / When it's useful

**Quick answer:** Attach the badge to a uniform, jacket, or display board using the rear clamp fasteners; check unit or organizational rules before wearing it on official duty uniforms.

In most cases, the badge is used to mark achievement, service, or collection value — useful for paratroopers, veterans, reenactors, and military surplus dealers. It also works well as a display piece on a board or in a shadow box.

### Care and notes

Basic care keeps the badge looking its best and avoids damage to both the badge and the fabric it's mounted on.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust; avoid abrasive cleaners and harsh chemicals.
- Fit clamp fasteners carefully to prevent stretching or damaging delicate uniform fabric.
- Store in a dry place to limit corrosion; prolonged exposure to moisture can affect the finish.
- Limited availability: items are produced in controlled quantities; order promptly if needed.

### FAQ

**Q:** What are the badge dimensions?

**A:** The badge measures 7.5 cm in width and 3.5 cm in height.

**Q:** What material is the badge made of?

**A:** It is made of burnished metal, chosen for durability and a uniform finish.



**Q:** How does the badge attach to clothing?

**A:** The badge uses rear clamp fasteners for secure mounting and easy removal.
