Product overview

The Targhetta Ricamata Soccorritore DAE is a stitched identification patch designed for rescuers authorized to use a defibrillator (DAE). It is made for medical responders, first aid teams, tactical medics, police and duty personnel who need clear, professional ID on their uniform or gear.



Definition: a durable embroidered patch that shows the word "Soccorritore" next to the DAE logo and attaches with rear Velcro. The patch combines a discreet black-on-black look with materials made to withstand regular use.

Main features

Compact, durable and simple to attach — this patch is built for duty use and easy visual identification in emergencies.

- **Professional design:** black embroidery on a black background for a low-profile, tactical appearance.
- **Clear identification:** the word "Soccorritore" appears beside the DAE logo to mark authorized rescuers.
- **Rear Velcro:** fast and secure attachment to uniforms, jackets and compatible gear.
- **Dimensions:** 11.5 cm width x 3 cm height — readable at a distance but compact.
- **Durable materials:** reinforced embroidery that holds up to frequent use and washing.
- **Water-resistant:** materials designed to resist moisture in typical field conditions.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: attach the patch by pressing the Velcro side onto a loop-panel on your uniform, jacket or bag. Use it wherever rapid identification of DAE-trained personnel is required.

In most cases, this patch is useful for emergency response teams, workplace first aiders, police and tactical medics who need an unobtrusive but visible ID. It helps colleagues and bystanders recognize who can operate the defibrillator during an incident.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the patch looking professional. Follow these practical tips to maintain performance and correct use.

- Attach only to garments or panels with compatible loop Velcro to ensure a secure fit.
- Machine wash garments as usual; the embroidery is designed to resist normal laundering, but avoid high-heat drying when possible.
- Note: the patch identifies authorized rescuers but does not replace training or certification for DAE use.

FAQ

Q: Is the patch water-resistant?

A: Yes. The patch is made from materials that resist water and moisture typical in field use, helping maintain its appearance.



Q: Can I personalize the patch with my name?

A: No. The patch is supplied only with the fixed wording "Soccorritore" and the DAE logo; personalization is not available.

Q: How do I attach the patch to clothing?

A: The patch has rear Velcro for quick attachment. Press it onto a loop-compatible area of a uniform, jacket or bag for a secure hold.

Q: What are the exact dimensions?

A: The patch measures 11.5 cm in width and 3 cm in height — compact but clearly visible from a short distance.

Q: Is the patch suitable for all uniforms?

A: In most cases, yes. It works with uniforms and garments that accept Velcro loop panels; check your uniform for a compatible surface first.

Q: Is this a certification or proof of training?

A: No. The patch serves as visual identification only and does not certify training or legal authorization to use the DAE.

Tip: Choose the right placement and check that your uniform has a loop Velcro panel before ordering. Consider pairing this patch with other duty or tactical ID patches for a complete responder kit.
