Definition: A Velcro-backed embroidered ID patch reading "Operatore" beside the DAE logo for quick visual identification of AED operators. This patch is suitable for tactical, duty, and police uniforms or work clothing.

Main features

Durable, low-profile design that balances visibility with a discreet black-on-black look. Key features include:

- **Professional embroidery:** Black thread on black background with "Operatore" and the DAE logo.
- **Velcro backing:** Hook-and-loop attachment for fast, secure mounting on uniforms and gear.
- **Robust materials:** Built to resist daily wear and maintain appearance over time.

How to use / When it's useful

Attach the patch to any garment or kit equipped with loop-side Velcro—jackets, chest rigs, uniform panels, or duty vests—so the Operatore DAE designation is immediately visible during an emergency. The slim profile keeps the patch readable while remaining discreet on tactical or police clothing.

Quick answer: Use the Velcro backing to attach or remove the patch in seconds. In most cases, it fits standard uniform Velcro panels and is ideal for first responders, medical technicians, and AED-trained staff working in tactical, duty, or police roles.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the patch looking professional and extends service life.

- Fasten Velcro before laundering to avoid snagging on other items.
- Hand wash or gentle machine cycle; avoid bleach and high heat drying.
- Water-resistant but not guaranteed waterproof—dry thoroughly after heavy exposure.
- Avoid ironing directly over the embroidered surface or Velcro backing.

FAQ



Q: Is the patch water-resistant?

A: Yes. The patch is made with water-resistant materials suitable for routine exposure to moisture. It is not marketed as fully waterproof for prolonged immersion.

Q: Can I customize the patch with a name?

A: No. This patch is supplied with the fixed designation "Operatore" alongside the DAE logo and is not available for personal name customization.

Q: How do I attach the patch to my uniform?

A: The patch has a Velcro (hook-and-loop) rear panel for quick attachment to loop-side surfaces on uniforms, vests, or gear. Press firmly to secure.

Q: What are the patch dimensions?

A: The patch measures 11.5 cm in width and 3 cm in height—designed to be visible without being bulky on tactical or duty uniforms.

Q: Is the patch suitable for all uniform types?

A: Yes. As long as the uniform or equipment has a compatible loop-side Velcro panel, the patch can be applied and removed easily.

Q: Is this product always in stock?

A: Stock can be limited due to demand. If availability is low, consider checking back or selecting related identification patches and accessories.

Tip: Choose the correct placement on your uniform and ensure the loop surface is clean for best adhesion. Consider browsing related tactical and duty identification patches to match your gear and role.
