The Fascetta Metallo 1940 is a small metal wreath bar intended for collectors, restorers, reenactors and anyone interested in military surplus and historic medals. Definition: it is a metal laurel wreath band stamped with the campaign year "1940", originally fitted to the ribbon of the commemorative 1940–43 medal.



This commemorative fascetta is a visible symbol of the 1940 campaign year and works well as a display or restoration detail for medals, tactical collections, and duty or police museum pieces.

Main features

Simple, durable design with clear historic inscription and compact dimensions.

- **Material:** durable metal construction designed to last.
- **Design:** fruiting laurel wreath with the year "1940" inscribed.
- **Dimensions:** 4 cm length × 0.6 cm height.

In most cases, the fascetta is used by collectors restoring original groupings, by museums for accurate displays, or by hobbyists adding period detail to tactical or military surplus items. Handle gently when fitting and use alongside a proper ribbon mount or display case.

Care and notes

Basic care will keep the metal fascetta in good condition and protect its finish and inscription.

- Store in a dry place and avoid prolonged exposure to moisture to reduce tarnishing.
- Clean gently with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- Each piece is supplied in protective packaging for transport and storage.
- Availability may be limited; check current stock before planning multiple restorations or displays.

Q: What are the dimensions of the Fascetta Metallo 1940?

A: The fascetta measures 4 cm in length and 0.6 cm in height. These compact dimensions make it easy to fit on standard medal ribbons.
