Product overview

The Metal Bar 1945 is a browned metal campaign bar (fascetta) showing a laurel wreath and the campaign year 1945; it was designed to mount on the ribbon of the 1943–45 commemorative medal. This item is aimed at collectors, museums, historical reenactors and military surplus



dealers who need authentic display pieces.

Definition: A fascetta is a small campaign bar attached to a medal ribbon to indicate service during a specific year. The Metal Bar 1945 is a historic piece representing the 1945 campaign year and was originally applied to the 1943–45 medal ribbon.

Main features

Compact, historically accurate, and ready for display on the matching medal ribbon.

- **Material:** Browned metal for an authentic period finish.
- **Historic design:** Fruited laurel wreath with the inscribed campaign year **1945**.
- **Attachment:** Rear pin fitting for mounting on the 1943–45 commemorative medal ribbon.
- **Size:** 4 cm length x 0.6 cm height — compact and unobtrusive on a ribbon.
- **Collector value:** Suitable for collectors, museums, reenactors and military surplus or tactical displays.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Attach the bar to the medal ribbon using the rear pin so the year and laurel face outward. In most cases, it is used to complete a 1943–45 commemorative medal set for display or collection.

Use it when restoring or presenting a period medal, preparing a museum or private display, or when assembling items for historical reenactment. It pairs directly with the 1943–45 ribbon and helps identify the campaign year.

Care and notes

Handle the metal bar carefully to preserve its finish and historical value.

- Store in a dry, stable environment to avoid corrosion or further patina.
- Avoid abrasive cleaning or harsh chemicals that could damage the browned finish.
- Secure the rear pin gently when mounting to prevent damage to the ribbon or bar.
- Availability may be limited due to its historical nature; consider storage for preservation.

FAQ

Q: What are the dimensions of the Metal Bar 1945?

A: The bar measures 4 cm in length and 0.6 cm in height. It is designed to be small and proportionate to the medal ribbon.

Q: What material is the fascetta made from?



A: It is made of browned metal, chosen to match the period finish used on campaign bars and medal fittings.

Q: How is the bar attached to the medal ribbon?

A: The bar has a rear pin fitting that allows it to be mounted onto the ribbon securely and displayed with the laurel and year visible.

Q: Is this an original World War II piece?

A: The item represents the campaign year 1945 and was used on the 1943–45 commemorative medal ribbon. It is offered as a historical campaign bar for collectors and displays.

Q: Can I buy more than one fascetta?

A: Yes, multiple pieces can be purchased where stock allows. Note that availability may be limited because of the item's historic nature.

Q: Is this suitable for tactical or police display collections?

A: Yes. While primarily a historical military item, it is suitable for military surplus, tactical, police or historical display collections and museum exhibits.

Tip: Choose the correct variant or size for your medal ribbon and browse related medal fittings and ribbons to complete your display. Store and handle the bar with care to preserve its historic finish.
