Product overview

The Battaglione San Marco belt is a service belt made for serving personnel of the Marina Militare and for licensed collectors. It is a hemp (amaranto) belt with a metal buckle screened with the winged lion of San Marco, intended as a symbol of unit identity and tradition.



Definition: a 4 cm high, 120 cm long hemp belt featuring a metal buckle with the San Marco emblem, reserved for Navy personnel and authorised collectors. Suitable for military, tactical or military surplus collectors looking for an authentic service item.

Main features

Durable, simple design focused on service use and collector authenticity.

- **Material:** Amaranto hemp webbing for long-lasting wear.
- **Buckle:** Metal buckle with serigraphed winged lion of San Marco and the inscription "PAX TIBI MARCE EVANGELISTA MEVS".
- **Dimensions:** Height 4 cm; Length 120 cm.
- **Fit:** Sized to suit a range of body types when worn as a service belt.
- **Restricted sale:** Available only to Marina Militare personnel or collectors with the required prefettizia license (art. 28 TULPS).
- **Authentication:** Sale requires a copy of the tesserino militare modello AT or other delivery arrangements via the relevant port authority.

How to use / When it's useful

Use the belt as part of a naval uniform or as a display item for collections of military surplus and tactical gear. It is designed to be worn at the waist as a standard service belt or stored as a collectible piece of unit heritage.

Quick answer: this product is for serving Marina Militare personnel and licensed collectors only. In most cases, you must submit a copy of the tesserino militare modello AT or, for delivery, indicate the capitaneria di porto where you serve; collectors must provide the prefettizia license under art. 28 TULPS.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the belt presentable and preserves the buckle finish; follow these simple recommendations.

- Spot clean the hemp with a damp cloth; avoid aggressive washing to protect the fabric and buckle.
- Wipe the metal buckle with a soft, dry cloth to remove moisture and fingerprints.
- Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent fading or mildew.
- Sale is subject to verification: provide required ID or delivery details as described; collectors must supply the prefettizia license (art. 28 TULPS).

FAQ

Q: Who can buy the Battaglione San Marco belt?



A: The belt is reserved for Marina Militare personnel and for collectors who hold a prefettizia license in accordance with art. 28 TULPS. Purchase requires document verification.

Q: What are the exact dimensions of the belt?

A: The belt is 4 cm high and 120 cm long. These measurements are the standard specification for this model.

Q: What materials are used in the belt?

A: The webbing is amaranto hemp and the buckle is metal with a serigraphed image of the winged lion of San Marco.

Q: How do I prove I belong to the Marina Militare?

A: You must send a copy of the tesserino militare modello AT or choose delivery to the capitaneria di porto where you serve, which should be indicated in your account address details.

Q: Can collectors purchase this belt?

A: Yes. Collectors must provide a copy of the prefettizia license as required by art. 28 TULPS for verification before purchase is completed.

Q: Is the belt suitable for tactical use?

A: The belt is a service/ceremonial style belt intended for uniform wear and collecting. It is part of military surplus and naval equipment categories rather than specialized tactical load-bearing gear.

Tip: Choose the correct length and verify delivery details before checkout; check related naval and military surplus items to complete your uniform or collection.
