and an M113 tank—plus a small round area for a battalion number.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the metal finish in good condition and preserves the emblem's detail.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust; avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Keep dry and store in a cool place to limit tarnishing over time.
- Check how you will attach the badge to your beret—mounting hardware or methods may differ.
- Limited availability: this item is produced in small quantities, so availability can change.

A: The badge measures 5.5 cm in diameter. This size is chosen to be clearly visible on standard berets without being bulky.
