Product overview

The Ferita Servizio Kaki is a khaki-backed service wound badge designed for military personnel, reserve forces, uniformed services and collectors who follow official uniform rules. It is suitable for duty uniforms and ceremonial jackets used in tactical or military surplus applications.



Definition: The Ferita Servizio Kaki is a service wound badge made of silvered metal wire gallon stripes mounted on khaki fabric for attachment to the right sleeve.

Main features

Clear, durable construction and standard placement make this badge easy to recognise and display on service dress or work uniforms.

- **Material:** Gallon stripes in silvered metal wire for lasting appearance.
- **Length:** Each stripe is approximately 50 mm long.
- **Thickness:** Thickness is listed in sources at around 6–8 mm.
- **Backing:** Khaki fabric underlay for sewing or mounting on the sleeve.
- **Placement details:** Applied at a 45° forward-and-down angle on the right sleeve.
- **Clean layout:** Additional badges are spaced 3 mm apart to keep a neat, professional look.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Mount the Ferita Servizio Kaki on the right sleeve of the jacket with the lower end forward, about 15 cm from the shoulder seam, at a 45° angle. This follows standard placement instructions for service wound badges.

In most cases, wearers use the badge on service or ceremonial uniforms to show recognised service wounds; if both a ferita in guerra and ferita in servizio are worn, the ferita in guerra is placed above the ferita in servizio. The badge is also appropriate for uniformed police and duty outfits when regulations allow.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves appearance and ensures compliance with uniform standards; follow placement and spacing rules when mounting multiple badges.

- Store flat and away from moisture to protect the silvered metal wire.
- Handle carefully to avoid bending the metal gallon stripes.
- Follow the 45° placement and the 15 cm from-shoulder guideline for correct wear.
- Keep subsequent badges 3 mm apart and place any ferita in guerra above the ferita in servizio.

FAQ

Q: How is the Ferita Servizio Kaki applied?

A: The badge is mounted on the right sleeve with a 45° forward-and-down tilt, lower end forward, about 15 cm from the shoulder seam. Sew or attach it through the khaki backing as required by your uniform regulations.



Q: What are the dimensions of the gallon stripe?

A: Each stripe is approximately 50 mm long. Thickness is reported around 6–8 mm in available descriptions; please check the specific variant before ordering.

Q: What material are the stripes made from?

A: The stripes are made from silvered metal wire, chosen for durability and a clean appearance on service uniforms.

Q: How far apart should multiple badges be placed?

A: When wearing multiple ferita in servizio badges, maintain a 3 mm gap between each stripe to keep the layout orderly and compliant with standard practice.

Q: What is the hierarchy between ferita in guerra and ferita in servizio?

A: If a wearer has both a ferita in guerra and a ferita in servizio, the ferita in guerra is positioned above the ferita in servizio to respect the established order of precedence.

Q: Is the Ferita Servizio Kaki available now?

A: Availability can be limited due to demand. Check current stock on the product page and select the correct variant before adding to cart.
