## Product short description:

## Product overview

The Mostrine Genio Guastatori Paracadutisti are enamelled metal rank badges made for members of the 8° Reggimento Genio Guastatori Paracadutisti. They are intended for Army



personnel and for accredited collectors who hold the required authorization.

Definition: a pair of rectangular enamelled metal insignia (25 x 50 mm) with a screw-type rear fastener, worn as regimental identification. Ideal for tactical, military surplus, and duty insignia collections.

### Main features

Cleanly detailed enamel design and a secure screw-back fastener make these badges suitable for display, uniform wear, or collection.

- **Official design:** rectangular badge with a black flame edged in crimson, a five-point silver star at center, and a blue field showing a flaming grenade on a gladius topped by a winged parachute.
- **High-quality material:** enamelled metal construction for a crisp finish and lasting appearance.
- **Secure attachment:** rear screw fastener for reliable hold during daily wear and demanding use.
- **Size:** 25 x 50 mm — visible but not bulky on uniform or display board.
- **Targeted availability:** reserved for Army personnel; collectors may purchase with proper licensing (ex art. 28 TULPS).

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: these mostrine are worn as regimental insignia on uniforms or kept as part of a tactical/military surplus collection. They suit both active duty display and collector presentation.

In most cases, attach the badge by screwing the rear fastener into the uniform tab or display backing. Use them when representing unit membership, for ceremonial dress, or for authenticated collection items.

### Care and notes

Simple care keeps the enamel and metal finish in good condition; handle with care to avoid scratches and store in a dry place.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Keep dry to prevent corrosion of metal components.
- Sale restricted: purchase requires verification of military service or a collector's prefectural license (ex art. 28 TULPS).
- Provide accurate delivery information — barracks address may be required for verification.

### FAQ



**Q:** Who can buy the Mostrine Genio Guastatori Paracadutisti?

**A:** The product is reserved for Army personnel. Accredited collectors may buy them if they provide the required prefectural license under art. 28 TULPS.

**Q:** What are the dimensions of the badges?

**A:** Each badge measures 25 x 50 mm. They are sized to be visible on uniform tabs without being overly large.

**Q:** What material are the insignia made from?

**A:** The badges are enamelled metal, offering a clear finish and good longevity when cared for properly.

**Q:** How do I prove I am eligible to purchase?

**A:** You must send a copy of your military ID or provide your barracks address during site registration so staff can verify service before enabling purchase.

**Q:** Can collectors purchase these mostrine?

**A:** Yes. Collectors must submit a copy of the prefectural license (ex art. 28 TULPS) to qualify for purchase and verification.

**Q:** How is the badge attached to clothing?

**A:** The badges use a rear screw-type fastener. Screw the back post securely to the uniform tab or display mounting to keep the badge in place.

**Tip:** Choose the correct variant and confirm eligibility before ordering; check related tactical insignia and military surplus items to complete your uniform or collection.
