## **Product short description:**

## **Product overview**

The Spanish grey-green beret of the 9° Col Moschin is a military-style headwear item designed for military personnel, tactical users, and civilians who prefer a duty or military surplus look. It is a durable, regulation-style beret made for practical use, training and casual wear.



**Definition:** This is a wool-blend Spanish-style beret in grey-green, used by the 9° Col Moschin and offered without a unit badge for civilian sale.

## Main features

Built for durability and everyday wear, this beret combines traditional styling with functional details suited to tactical, duty and casual use.

- **Material:** 94% wool, 6% viscose for comfort and shape retention.
- **Edge:** Black gros-grain trim for added strength at high-wear points.
- **Adjustable fit:** Rear straps allow size adjustment for a stable fit.
- **Available sizes:** 57, 58, 59, 60 (see sizing guide below).
- **No badge:** Supplied without insignia, available for civilian purchase and styling.
- **Designed for varied use:** Suitable for operational training, tactical-style outfits and everyday military-inspired fashion.

## How to use / When it's useful

**Quick answer:** Wear the beret for field training, tactical-style uniforms, duty-style looks or as a military-surplus fashion accessory. It works well in varied environments where a reliable, structured headwear is needed.

In most cases, choose the size that matches your head circumference to ensure proper fit and comfort. To measure: 1) Place a soft measuring tape around the head at mid-forehead, just above the ears. 2) Record the circumference where the tape meets. 3) Match your measurement to the size chart: Size 57 = 56–57 cm, Size 58 = 57–58 cm, Size 59 = 58–59 cm, Size 60 = 59–60 cm.

## Care and notes

Basic care will preserve shape and fabric performance. Follow these simple steps and precautions to keep the beret in good condition.

- Prefer professional dry cleaning or gentle hand wash in cold water; avoid harsh detergents.
- Do not tumble dry; reshape while damp and air dry flat to maintain the beret's form.
- Avoid direct heat and prolonged sun exposure which can damage wool and the gros-grain trim.
- Note: the beret is supplied without a badge and is available for civilian purchase.

## FAQ

**Q:** What is the beret made of?

**A:** The beret is made of 94% wool and 6% viscose, with a black gros-grain edge for added



durability.

**Q:** Which sizes are available?

**A:** Available sizes are 57, 58, 59 and 60. Each size corresponds to a head circumference range (Size 57 = 56–57 cm, up to Size 60 = 59–60 cm).

**Q:** How do I find the right size?

**A:** Measure head circumference with a soft tape placed around the mid-forehead and above the ears, then match the measurement to the size chart provided above.

**Q:** Is the beret sold to civilians?

**A:** Yes. The beret is supplied without a unit badge, so it is available for civilian purchase and everyday wear.

**Q:** Is the beret suitable for tactical or duty use?

**A:** The beret is designed to meet practical needs for training and duty-style wear, offering durability and a stable fit for routine use.

**Q:** How should I clean and store the beret?

**A:** Best practice is professional dry cleaning or gentle hand washing in cold water, then air drying flat and reshaping to keep the structure intact.

**Tip:** Choose the correct size for comfort and fit, and consider browsing related tactical and military surplus items to complete a coordinated duty or casual military-style outfit.
