Product overview

The Fregio Basco Trasmissioni is a metal beret badge intended for members of the Corpo delle Trasmissioni dell'Esercito Italiano and for verified collectors. It identifies service in the transmissions corps and is designed to be worn on the basco (beret).



Definition: the Fregio Basco Trasmissioni is a 5.5 cm silvered, browned metal insignia worn on the beret to indicate belonging to the Italian Army Transmissions Corps. This item is of interest to military, tactical, and military surplus collectors and for duty display.

Main features

Key features and benefits at a glance.

- **Distinctive design:** Two crossed axes inside a ring, topped by a grenade with a six-flame, folded to the wearer's left; at the axes' intersection a circular radio antenna emits eight lightning bolts, symbolizing communications and transmission.
- **High-quality material:** Made in silvered, browned metal for durability and a consistent appearance over time.
- **Perfect size:** 5.5 cm diameter — proportioned to sit cleanly on the beret without being bulky.
- **Symbol of membership:** Signifies professional affiliation with the Corpo delle Trasmissioni and is suitable for display by verified collectors.
- **Secure fit:** Designed for straightforward, stable attachment to the beret, suitable for service and ceremonial use.
- **Collector value:** Limited availability makes it sought after by military surplus and tactical collectors.

How to use / When it's useful

Use this fregio on the basco (beret) as part of service dress, for ceremonial wear, or as a collection/display piece. Quick answer: it is designed to be attached to the beret and kept stable during normal wear.

In most cases, members of the Corpo delle Trasmissioni will wear it on their service or ceremonial beret; verified collectors generally use it for display or preservation in a collection. Follow your unit or collecting association rules before wearing the insignia on a uniform.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the metal finish in good condition and preserves the badge for wear or display.

- Store in a dry place and avoid prolonged exposure to moisture to prevent surface changes.
- Clean gently with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- Handle with care to avoid bending or damaging attachment points.
- Availability: sold to military personnel and verified collectors; stock is limited—verify eligibility before ordering.

Q: What are the dimensions of the Fregio Basco Trasmissioni?

A: The badge measures 5.5 cm in diameter. This size is intended to sit proportionally on a standard beret without appearing oversized.

Q: What material is the fregio made from?

A: It is made from silvered, browned metal. The finish is chosen for durability and to maintain a consistent appearance over time.

Q: Who can wear the Fregio Basco Trasmissioni?

A: It is intended for members of the Corpo delle Trasmissioni dell'Esercito Italiano and for verified collectors. Buyers should confirm eligibility according to applicable rules or regulations.

Q: How is the fregio attached to the beret?

A: The design allows for straightforward and secure attachment to the beret. Specific fixing methods may vary; follow your unit guidelines or a jeweler's advice if a replacement fitting is needed.

Q: Can civilians buy this fregio?

A: Civilians who are verified collectors may be eligible to purchase. The product is reserved and availability is limited, so verification may be required at checkout.

Q: Is this fregio suitable for display in a military surplus or tactical collection?

A: Yes. It is appropriate for military surplus, tactical, and duty-related collections, provided display and handling respect any legal or regulatory restrictions.
