Product overview

The Medaglia Croce Rossa Tedesca II Classe is a historic medal for collectors, military surplus buyers, museums and tactical or police history enthusiasts. It is suitable for display, reference



collections or careful wear on period uniforms.

Definition: a Second Class German Red Cross-style cross medal in silvered metal with white enamel, a red enameled central cross and laurel fronds.

Main features

Clear, well-documented features useful for collectors and resale listings.

- **Material:** silvered metal with white enamel finish.
- **Central motif:** red enameled cross surrounded by two silvered laurel fronds.
- **Reverse inscription:** raised letters reading "Für Verdienste Um Das Deutsche Rote Kreuz".
- **Ribbon:** 37 mm wide white ribbon with an 18 mm central vertical red stripe and two 2 mm thin edge stripes.
- **Attachment:** rear safety-pin style clasp for secure fastening.
- **Size:** cross diameter 4.5 cm — suitable for display or wear.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use this medal as a display item in a collection, a museum exhibit, or for historical uniform presentation. Handle by the edges and keep the ribbon straight when mounting.

In most cases, collectors place the medal in a shadow box or on a medal board; tactical and military surplus buyers use it for reference, study, or careful historical reenactment. It is not a certified modern award for active duty use.

Care and notes

Basic care preserves enamel and plating; treat the medal as a delicate historical object.

- Store in a dry, padded container away from direct sunlight.
- Avoid abrasive polishing that could remove silvering or damage enamel.
- Handle minimally and by the edges to protect the finish and inscription.
- Verify condition and provenance if purchasing for serious historical or investment purposes.

FAQ

Q: What are the dimensions of the cross?

A: The cross measures 4.5 cm in diameter. This size is suitable for display or mounting on a medal board.

Q: What material is the medal made of?



A: The medal is made of silvered metal and finished with white enamel on the cross surfaces.

Q: What is engraved on the back of the medal?

A: The reverse bears a raised inscription: "Für Verdienste Um Das Deutsche Rote Kreuz" (for services to the Croce Rossa Tedesca).

Q: How does the medal attach to clothing or a display?

A: It uses a rear safety-pin style clasp for easy application and removal, suitable for secure mounting or temporary wear.

Q: What are the ribbon details?

A: The ribbon is 37 mm wide, white with an 18 mm central vertical red stripe and two 2 mm thin edge stripes as described.

Q: Is this medal suitable for reenactment or official use?

A: It is appropriate for historical reenactment, display, or collection use. It is not a modern official award for active service.
