Product overview

The 300th Anniversary Commemorative Medal marks the promulgation of the Bolla Militantis Ecclesiae (27 April 1718) and honors the historic succession known as the Primogenitura Farnesiana. It is designed for collectors, members of chivalric orders, and military surplus or tactical memorabilia enthusiasts who value historical insignia.

Definition: a commemorative medal issued to celebrate three centuries since Pope Clemente XI confirmed the dynastic succession of the Gran Magistero to the Farnese line within the Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio.

Main features

Carefully produced to reflect the anniversary and suitable for display or ceremonial wear.

- Two sizes: 37 mm (display or ceremonial) and 20 mm (discreet, everyday or compact collections)
- Material: silvered, browned metal finish for a solemn, aged appearance
- Ribbon: blue with three vertical gold pales symbolizing the three centuries since the Bolla

How to use / When it's useful

Wear the larger 37 mm medal for formal events, ceremonies, or prominent display in a collection. The 20 mm version works well on a medal bar, in a compact case, or for daily wear by members or enthusiasts.

Quick answer: choose 37 mm for impact and display, 20 mm for discretion and everyday use. In most cases, collectors of military surplus, tactical and police memorabilia will prefer the 37 mm for presentation and the 20 mm for storage or uniform integration.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves the finish and detail of the medal over time.

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and fingerprints
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that could damage the silvered finish
- Store in a dry, padded case to prevent scratches and oxidation
- Handle by the edges to preserve detail on both faces

Q: What does this medal commemorate?

A: It commemorates the 300th anniversary of the Bolla Militantis Ecclesiae (27 April 1718) issued by Pope Clemente XI, which confirmed the dynastic succession of the Gran Magistero to the Farnese line.

Q: What sizes are available?

A: The medal is available in two sizes: 37 mm for a more visible display and 20 mm for a compact or everyday option.

Q: What is the medal made of?

A: Both sizes are produced in a silvered, browned metal finish that gives a solemn, slightly aged appearance while remaining durable for display or wear.

Q: What does the ribbon represent?

A: The blue ribbon with three vertical gold pales recalls the traditional colors of the Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio and symbolizes the three centuries since the Bolla's promulgation.

Q: Is this medal an official issue of the Order?

A: The medal commemorates the anniversary related to the Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio and the Primogenitura Farnesiana; descriptions identify historical links without claiming governmental or state honors.

Q: How long does shipping take?

A: Shipping times vary by seller and destination. Typical processing is rapid; confirm expected delivery times with the retailer at purchase.

Tip: Choose the 37 mm size for display or ceremonial use and the 20 mm for a compact or uniform-friendly option; consider browsing related commemorative and military surplus items to complete a themed collection.
