The Medaglia Giubileo Misericordia 2015 SMOM is a commemorative medal issued by the Sovereign Military Order of Malta for those involved in assistance to pilgrims during the Holy Year of Mercy (2015–2016) in Rome. It is suitable for collectors, historians, supporters of the Order, and enthusiasts of military insignia or military surplus memorabilia.



Definition: the Jubilee Mercy 2015 SMOM Medal is a 37 mm burnished metal medal awarded to recognize first aid and assistance to pilgrims during the 2015–2016 Holy Year of Mercy in Rome.

Main features

Compact and symbolic, the medal combines clear inscriptions and a distinctive ribbon to reflect its commemorative and humanitarian purpose.

- **Official inscription:** Obverse and reverse bear the Order's wording including "SOVRANO MILITARE ORDINE DI MALTA" and "PRONTO SOCCORSO AI PELLEGRINI".
- **Commemorative date:** Marked "ROMA 2015-2016" to indicate the Holy Year of Mercy.
- **Material and finish:** Made from burnished metal for a durable, classic look.
- **Ribbon design:** Red ribbon with a central white stripe and a yellow stripe on the white bar, symbolizing compassion and commitment.
- **Size:** Supplied only in a 37 mm diameter format to maintain consistent presentation.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: keep as a collector's item, display it in a case, or include it in a historical or ceremonial collection. The medal is primarily a commemorative piece rather than a functional tool.

In most cases, buyers are collectors, historians, or people connected to humanitarian service who value the medal for its historical and symbolic meaning. If you plan to wear the medal publicly, check any applicable dress rules or organizational guidelines first.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves appearance and inscription detail—store carefully and avoid harsh chemicals.

- Store in a dry, padded case to prevent scratches and tarnish.
- Clean gently with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or polishes not intended for burnished metal.
- Handle by the ribbon when possible to protect the medal surface and inscriptions.
- Note limited quantities: availability is restricted, so consider purchase timing.
