Product overview

The Fregio Basco Brunito Arditi Incursori Marina is a 4.4 cm burnished metal beret badge



designed for members of the Arditi Incursori, the special forces of the Italian Marina Militare. It is intended for authorized personnel who wear the unit uniform and insignia.

Definition: a brunished metal beret badge (4.4 cm) bearing the ARDITI INCURSORI inscription and symbolic elements (gladius, anchor, nautical rope). The badge serves as a visible symbol of unit affiliation and professional identity in tactical and military duty contexts.

Main features

Key features include durable materials, clear symbolic design, and a secure rear clamp attachment suitable for operational use.

- **Material and finish:** brunished (darkened) metal for durability and a refined look.
- **Symbolic design:** ARDITI INCURSORI inscription framed by laurel, with a gladius crossed with an anchor and a nautical rope—representing strength, maritime tradition, and seamanship.
- **Size:** 4.4 cm diameter—visible yet discreet for beret wear.
- **Attachment:** rear clamp system designed for a secure fit on a beret during active use.
- **Availability:** limited quantities; purchase is restricted to authorized personnel and subject to verification.

How to use / When it's useful

Wear the badge centered on the beret as part of the unit uniform; align the design so the inscription and emblem are upright. Check the rear clamps before use to ensure the badge is firmly fixed and will not shift during movement.

Quick answer: attach using the rear clamps and confirm a secure fit before field use. In most cases, purchase requires proof of membership with the Arditi Incursori and verification by Tutto Militare before the order is accepted.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves finish and attachment reliability; follow these practical notes before and after use.

- Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the brunished finish.
- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and moisture; store in a dry place.
- Check the clamp attachment periodically and tighten or replace if worn.
- Sale restricted to authorized Arditi Incursori personnel—proof of service is required for purchase.

FAQ



Q: Who can buy the Fregio Basco Brunito Arditi Incursori Marina?

A: Only authorized members of the Arditi Incursori (Marina Militare) can purchase this badge. Tutto Militare requires documentation to verify eligibility before completing the sale.

Q: What are the badge dimensions?

A: The badge measures 4.4 cm in diameter, a size chosen to balance visibility and discretion on the beret.

Q: What material is the badge made from?

A: The badge is made from brunished (darkened) metal, providing durability and a refined appearance suitable for duty and ceremonial wear.

Q: How is the badge fixed to the beret?

A: It uses a rear clamp attachment that holds the badge securely to the beret. Inspect clamps before use to ensure a firm, stable fit during operations.

Q: Do I need to provide documentation to buy this badge?

A: Yes. Buyers must submit proof of membership or service with the Arditi Incursori (for example, an ID card or service certificate) for verification prior to purchase approval.

Q: Is this badge an original unit insignia?

A: The badge reproduces the emblem and inscription associated with the Arditi Incursori. Sales and distribution are controlled by Tutto Militare through a verification process to ensure authorized issue.

Tip: Choose the correct badge and check clamp condition before ordering; if you are eligible, select related beret and uniform accessories to complete the look without delay. Consider browsing similar tactical and military surplus items for matching gear.
