This product is a pair of **Mostrine Reichsführer-SS** collar insignia reproduced for collectors, museums, and historical reenactors. They recreate the highest-rank collar tabs used by the



Reichsführer-SS and are intended for display or educational use.

Definition: These are reproduction collar patches made from black cloth with silver and gold bullion-style embroidery that replicate a historic SS rank insignia. Suitable for military surplus collectors, tactical gear enthusiasts, and historical collectibles markets.

Main features

Well-crafted reproductions that replicate historic materials and visual details while remaining suitable for careful display or period events.

- **Materials:** Black cloth base embroidered with silver-colored bullion thread and gold-colored bullion thread for decorative elements.
- **Design:** Central motif of three oak leaves surrounded by two laurel wreaths in gold-coloured bullion thread.
- **Edge finish:** Braided silver-colour bullion trim around each tab.
- **Pair:** Sold as a matching set of two collar tabs.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Use these collar tabs for display, museum exhibits, collection cataloguing, or carefully supervised historical reenactment events. They are primarily intended for collectors and educational purposes.

In most cases, they are mounted on uniforms for display or attached temporarily during reenactments and living-history events. Handle with care to preserve the embroidery and braided trim; avoid rough use or exposure to moisture.

Care and notes

Follow simple storage and handling to keep the embroidered threads and cloth in good condition.

- Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent fading or deterioration.
- Handle by the edges and avoid excessive bending to protect the bullion-style threads.
- Intended for collectors and reenactors; keep out of reach of children.
- These items are reproductions based on historic designs and not original wartime uniforms.

Q: What materials are used for the collar tabs?

A: The tabs are made from black cloth embroidered with silver-coloured and gold-coloured bullion-



style thread, with a braided silver-colour trim.

Q: What do the oak leaves and laurel wreaths represent?

A: The oak leaves and laurel wreaths are traditional symbols used to convey authority and rank in historic military insignia; they are replicated here for historical accuracy.

A: They can be worn for supervised historical reenactments or display with period uniforms. They are primarily marketed to collectors and reenactors.

Q: How should I store the collar tabs?

A: Store them flat in a dry, dark place away from direct sunlight. Avoid humidity and folding to preserve the embroidery and trim.
