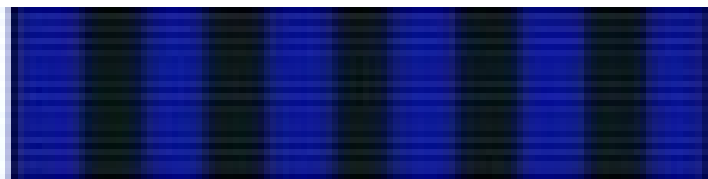

## Product short description:

The "Nastrino Operazioni Militari Africa Orientale 1935/36" is a commemorative campaign ribbon honoring those who served in the East Africa operations of 1935–36. Designed for collectors and military memorabilia enthusiasts, it fits well in personal collections or display exhibits.

## Product overview

The Nastrino Operazioni Militari Africa Orientale 1935/36 is a reproduction ribbon issued to commemorate Italian military operations in East Africa between 1935 and 1936. It is intended for military surplus collectors, historical reenactors, and anyone restoring or displaying period medals and ribbon bars.

Definition: this is a faithful reproduction ribbon in blue and black that mirrors the original ribbon



awarded to participants in the 1935–1936 East Africa operations.

### Main features

Designed for accuracy and display, the ribbon is available in standard widths and with optional mounting accessories to suit medal bars and collector displays.

- **Authentic colors:** blue and black, faithful to the original 1935/36 ribbon.
- **Reproduction:** accurate replica of the ribbon used for the East Africa operations.
- **Available sizes:** 37 mm and 20 mm widths to fit standard ribbon bars and narrower medal fittings.
- **Two finishes:** flat regulation finish or slightly domed "Elite" variant for a different visual effect.
- **Optional accessories:** available with ribbon-bar mounts fitted with rear clamps or screws (selectable).
- **Sold as ribbon or loose tape:** can be purchased as mounted ribbons or as loose ribbon for medals or custom mounting.

### How to use / When it's useful

Use this ribbon for museum displays, uniform restoration, private collections, and tactical/military surplus showcases. It fits standard ribbon bars and can replace damaged or missing ribbons on period medal sets.

Quick answer: this ribbon is best for collectors, reenactors, and display use. In most cases, choose the 37 mm version for standard ribbon bars and the 20 mm version for narrow medals or compact displays.

### Care and notes

Keep the ribbon in good condition with simple care and the correct mounting choice.

- Store in a dry place away from prolonged direct sunlight to prevent fading.
- Avoid machine washing or exposure to solvents; clean gently if needed.
- Note that the gladius device shown in historical examples is not included with the ribbon.
- This product is a reproduction, not an original issued medal ribbon from 1935–1936.
- Select the desired mount type (clamps or screws) when ordering to ensure proper fit.

### FAQ

**Q:** What are the ribbon colors?

**A:** The ribbon is blue and black, matching the historic coloring of the 1935/36 East Africa operations ribbon.



**Q:** What sizes are available?

**A:** It is available in two standard widths: 37 mm and 20 mm. Choose based on the type of ribbon bar or medal you are fitting.

**Q:** Can I buy the ribbon with mounting hardware?

**A:** Yes. You can order the ribbon mounted on a ribbon bar with rear clamps or with screws. Select the mounting option when you choose the product variant.

**Q:** Is the slightly domed "Elite" version different in size?

**A:** The Elite variant has a slightly domed finish for a different look but retains the same available widths (37 mm and 20 mm).

**Q:** Is this an original 1935–36 ribbon?

**A:** No, this item is a faithful reproduction intended for display, collection, or uniform restoration—not an original issued ribbon from that period.

**Q:** Is the gladius device included?

**A:** No. The original ribbon could be mounted with a gladius device for combatants; that device is not included with this reproduction ribbon.

**Tip:** Choose the right width (37 mm for standard ribbon bars, 20 mm for narrow medals) and select the preferred mounting option. Browse related military surplus ribbons and ribbon bars to complete a matched display or restoration set.
