The Foldable Olive Drab Spent Magazine Pouch is a compact, duty-ready pouch for shooters,



law enforcement, and military surplus users who need a simple way to collect and carry empty magazines, casings, and small items. It suits range days, training, patrols and any situation where quick access and compact storage matter.

Definition: a foldable pouch made to hold spent magazines and small items safely while attached to a belt. Built with Cordura 1000D exterior and Nylon 210T lining, it balances durability with low bulk when folded.

Main features

Key construction and design points that improve reliability and usability:

- **Cordura 1000D exterior** and **Nylon 210T lining** for wear resistance and light interior finish.
- **Foldable design:** compacts to 24 cm W x 10 cm H x 4 cm D for easy storage.
- **Open size:** 24 cm W x 28 cm H, giving room for spent magazines, casings, and small gear.
- **Double-security belt attachments:** Velcro plus snap fasteners for a secure mount to most belts.
- **Elastic closure** to keep contents in place and prevent accidental loss.
- **Drainage grommets** to let water escape and reduce pooling inside the pouch.
- **Reinforced opening** with a polyurethane strip for easier access and consistent shape.

How to use / When it's useful

Attach the pouch to your belt using the Velcro and snap fasteners, unfold it when you need to collect spent magazines or small parts, then secure the elastic closure. When not in use, fold it flat to save space in your kit or range bag.

Quick answer: use it on range days, training, or patrols to keep spent magazines and small items contained. In most cases, the pouch is used for empty magazines, brass casings, and similar small items in tactical, police, or duty contexts.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the pouch functional and extends its service life. Note: drainage grommets help water exit but do not make the pouch fully waterproof.

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth; air dry completely before storage.
- Avoid machine washing or harsh solvents that can damage Cordura or the polyurethane strip.
- Do not store wet or corrosive items inside for long periods to protect both contents and fabric.

FAQ



Q: What are the folded dimensions?

A: Folded dimensions are 24 cm wide x 10 cm high x 4 cm deep. It packs flat for easy storage in a bag or kit.

Q: What size is the pouch when opened?

A: Open dimensions are 24 cm wide x 28 cm high, providing enough capacity for several spent magazines or a small volume of casings and items.

Q: What materials is the pouch made from?

A: The exterior is Cordura 1000D and the lining is Nylon 210T. These materials offer abrasion resistance and a durable interior finish.

Q: Is the pouch waterproof?

A: No. It includes drainage grommets to allow water to exit and reduce pooling, but it is not fully waterproof or submersion-rated.

Q: How does the pouch attach to my belt?

A: It uses a double-security system: Velcro straps plus snap (automatic) fasteners. This gives a secure fit on most duty and tactical belts.

Q: What can I store in the pouch?

A: The pouch is designed for spent magazines and brass casings, plus other small items like loader tools or spare parts. It is not intended for live ammunition storage.

Tip: Choose the olive drab variant that matches your kit and check belt compatibility before purchase; browse related tactical and military surplus pouches to build a complete setup.
