The Medaglia Valore Militare Savoia Argentata is a silvered military valor medal crafted to honor individuals recognized for notable courage and dedication. Ideal for collectors, history enthusiasts, museums and ceremonial presentation.

Product overview

The Medaglia Valore Militare Savoia Argentata is a period military medal intended for collectors, museums, and military history enthusiasts. It honors non-commissioned officers and soldiers recognized for notable acts of bravery in war.

Definition: a silver Savoia campaign medal, historically issued under King Carlo Alberto of Savoy and engraved with the recipient's name.



Main features

Compact, historically detailed and suitable for display or safe storage.

- **Historic design:** obverse shows the Savoia shield framed by laurel branches and the royal crown with the inscription “al valor militare”; reverse bears laurel branches enclosing the recipient’s name, location and date of the action.
- **Period piece:** described as a vintage (d'epoca) military medal from the Savoia era.
- **Size:** 37 mm diameter, ideal for presentation cases or shadow boxes.
- **Material:** crafted in silver for an elegant, durable finish.
- **Nominative engraving:** example listing shows the name MARIO BIANCHI—each piece is individually named.
- **Collectible value:** significant historical and symbolic value for collectors of military surplus and memorabilia.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use this medal as a display piece, part of a curated collection, or as an archival item for study. It is not intended for active uniform use.

In most cases, collectors place it in a protective case or frame to preserve the engraving and silver finish. It is useful for museum exhibits, private collections, and historical research.

Care and notes

Handle and store the medal carefully to preserve its historical detail and silver surface.

- Store in a dry, padded case to avoid scratches and tarnishing.
- Clean gently with a soft cloth; avoid abrasive chemicals that may harm silver or inscriptions.
- Confirm the nominative inscription and provenance shown in the listing before purchase.
- Note limited availability: pieces are offered in small quantities and may be sought after by collectors.

FAQ

Q: What is the diameter of the medal?

A: The medal measures 37 mm in diameter. This size is suitable for display or storage in standard collector cases.

Q: What material is the medal made from?

A: The medal is made of silver. Silver offers a durable and historically appropriate finish for this type of piece.



Q: Is the medal engraved with a name?

A: Yes. The reverse can show the recipient's name, place and date. The example listing includes the nominative MARIO BIANCHI.

Q: What does the medal represent?

A: It was instituted to honor non-commissioned officers and soldiers who performed actions of notable military value. It is a symbol of historic military merit.

Q: When was this medal originally issued?

A: The medal was established under King Carlo Alberto of Savoy. Listed examples are described as period pieces from that historical era.

Q: Is this medal a good item for collectors?

A: Yes. Due to its historical design, nominative engraving and limited availability, it is well suited to collectors of military surplus, historians and museums.
