**Definition:** the Medaglia Valore Militare Savoia Oro (M.O.V.M.) is a gold medal established by King Vittorio Amedeo III of Savoy on 21 May 1793 to recognize extraordinary wartime bravery.

### Main features

This medal combines historical significance with refined design and is supplied on a 37 mm blue ribbon suitable for display or collection.

- **Historic origin:** Instituted 21 May 1793 by King Vittorio Amedeo III of Savoy.
- **Material:** Gold construction as described in the original specification.

### Care and notes

Handle the medal carefully and store it in a dry, stable environment to protect the metal and ribbon. Limited availability may affect delivery time.

- Store in a padded case or archival box to avoid scratches.
- Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners on the gold finish.
- Keep the ribbon away from moisture and direct sunlight to prevent fading.
- Note: only the standard 37 mm format is available; no customization offered.
- Availability is limited—purchase promptly if you need this specific piece.

**A:** The medal is available only in the 37 mm format and is mounted on a 37 mm wide blue ribbon.
