Main features

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the cross attractive and preserves its enamel and gilt details.

- Store in a dry, padded box to prevent scratches and avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that may damage enamel or gilt.
- Handle by the ribbon or edges to limit fingerprints on the gold and enamel surfaces.
- Note: this item is decorative and ceremonial; it is not a certified protective device or official service badge.

Q: What sizes does the cross come in?



A: The cross is available in two sizes: a standard 37 mm version and a reduced format with a 12 mm ribbon. Choose based on whether you plan to wear it or display it.

Q: What materials are used in the cross?

A: The cross features a gold-toned finish with white enamel on the face and gold-incised details on a blue circlet. The ribbon is fabric with three red and two black bands.

Q: What do the dates on the back mean?

A: The engraved dates refer to historical restorations and reforms tied to papal periods: they are shown on the reverse as part of the cross's historic design language.

Q: Who can receive this cross?

A: Traditionally the decoration recognizes laypeople and clergy for significant service to the Church or excellence in professional and artistic fields. This product is supplied as a ceremonial insignia.

Q: Is this cross an official Vatican-issued decoration?

A: This listing describes the cross as a ceremonial honor badge reflecting historic Papal imagery. The product page states its design and symbolism; for questions about official conferment, consult the issuing authority.
