Product overview

The Croce Cavaliere di Grazia of the Sacro Militare Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio e Due Sicilie is a ceremonial neck badge for collectors, members of chivalric orders, and buyers of historical or commemorative insignia. It is a decorated cross in the Greek form, enamelled red/purple, with historic symbols and an azure ribbon.

Definition: a ceremonial knight's cross worn or displayed to represent affiliation, tradition and ceremonial honour. This item also appeals to collectors of military surplus, tactical memorabilia and duty or police ceremonial pieces.

Main features

Key design elements and specifications that define the Croce Cavaliere di Grazia:

- **Greek cross shape:** a fleur-ended (gigliata) design enamelled in deep red/purple.
- **Historic letters:** the four arms show I.H.S.V., the Latin acronym for "In Hoc Signo Vinces".
- **Central christogram:** the XP christogram at the centre, flanked by the Greek letters Alpha and Omega.
- **Gold/coloured crown:** a red/enamelled golden crown tops the cross, signifying nobility and authority.
- **Azure ribbon:** the cross hangs from a light blue ribbon, the traditional colour of the Order.
- **Two sizes available:** 37 mm for regular wear and 20 mm for formal or gala occasions.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the cross for official Order ceremonies, formal events, display in a collection, or as a commemorative insignia. In most cases, members should follow the Order's protocol for wearing insignia at public or private events.

The cross is suitable for formal dress at investitures, gala events, museum or private displays, and as a collector's piece. It can be worn on the ribbon around the neck or kept as a display item depending on the size chosen (37 mm for regular wear, 20 mm for formal dress).

Care and notes

Keep the cross in good condition with simple, careful handling and storage.

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that could damage enamel.
- Store in a dry, padded case to protect the enamel and metal finish from scratches.
- Handle by the edges of the ribbon or suspension to reduce wear on enamel surfaces.
- Note: availability is limited; stock may sell out due to demand.



FAQ

Q: What sizes does the Croce Cavaliere di Grazia come in?

A: The cross is offered in two sizes: 37 mm intended for regular wear and 20 mm intended for formal or gala occasions. Choose based on how you plan to wear or display it.

Q: What do the letters I.H.S.V. mean?

A: I.H.S.V. stands for the Latin phrase "In Hoc Signo Vinces" (With This Sign You Will Conquer). It is a traditional motto linked to the Order's symbolism.

Q: What symbols appear at the centre of the cross?

A: The centre shows the XP christogram with the Greek letters Alpha and Omega on its arms, representing beginning and end in Christian symbolism.

Q: What does the blue ribbon represent?

A: The azure ribbon is the Order's traditional colour and signifies unity and cohesion among its members. It is the standard suspension for this insignia.

Q: Is this cross suitable for display in a collection of military surplus or tactical memorabilia?

A: Yes. The cross is commonly included in collections focusing on ceremonial, chivalric and historical insignia and can complement military surplus, tactical or duty-related displays.

Q: Is the cross an official symbol of the Order and can anyone wear it?

A: The item is a representation of the Sacro Militare Ordine Costantiniano di San Giorgio. Wearing it in official or public contexts should follow the Order's rules and any applicable protocols; buyers should confirm any ceremonial requirements with the issuing body.

Tip: Select the correct size (37 mm for regular wear, 20 mm for formal or gala use) and consider browsing related insignia or display cases to complete your presentation. Shopping early is recommended while limited stock remains.
