The Gilet Chest Rig MCR1 EVO is a durable, modular chest rig designed for professionals and outdoor enthusiasts who need organized, easy-to-reach gear. It suits users in tactical, police, duty



and military surplus contexts as well as serious outdoor activities.

Definition: The MCR1 EVO is a chest rig made from Cordura® 1000D that combines modular attachment, pockets and plate-ready capability for organized load carriage.

Main features

Key attributes that improve durability, comfort and modularity.

- **100% Cordura® 1000D** construction with reinforced box stitching for wear resistance.
- **Foldable internal organizing panel** to keep items secure and accessible.
- **Two integrated side pockets** plus an **internal mesh map pocket** for documents and small tools.
- **Padded, adjustable shoulder straps** with rear retention straps for comfort during long use.
- **Full adjustability** in height and waist; waist adjustable from **86 cm to 127 cm**.
- **Front section prepared for ballistic plates** (plates not included) to allow added protection if required.
- **Front M.O.L.L.E. panel** and **Swivi-Lockster rotating rear buckles** for modular attachments and improved movement.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the rig over a base layer, adjust shoulder straps and waist for a snug fit, and arrange magazines, tools or medical items on the foldable panel and M.O.L.L.E. slots. It is designed for rapid access to essential gear in field, patrol or training environments.

In most cases, the MCR1 EVO serves as a lightweight, configurable load carriage system for tactical tasks, police duty, hunting or rugged outdoor activities. Use the internal map pocket for navigation papers and add pouches to the M.O.L.L.E. panel to tailor the setup to your mission.

Care and notes

Basic care extends service life and keeps fittings working reliably.

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth and mild soap; avoid bleach or harsh solvents.
- Air dry away from direct heat or sunlight to prevent material degradation.
- Inspect buckles, stitching and seams regularly for wear; repair or replace if damaged.
- Plates are not included; the rig alone does not provide ballistic protection without proper plates installed.

FAQ

Q: What material is the MCR1 EVO made of?



A: The rig is made from Cordura® 1000D, a heavy-duty fabric known for abrasion and tear resistance. Reinforced box stitching improves durability in high-stress areas.

Q: Is the chest rig compatible with ballistic plates?

A: Yes, the front section is prepared for insertion of front ballistic plates. Plates are not included and must be fitted separately according to the plate manufacturer's instructions.

Q: How adjustable is the rig?

A: The rig offers height and waist adjustments; the waist size adjusts from 86 cm to 127 cm for a wide range of body sizes. Shoulder straps are padded and fully adjustable for comfort.

Q: What pockets and storage does it include?

A: It includes two integrated side pockets, a foldable internal organizing panel and an internal mesh map pocket for documents and navigation aids. The front M.O.L.L.E. panel accepts additional pouches.

Q: Can I use this for daily duty or outdoor activities?

A: Yes. The MCR1 EVO is designed for both professional duty use and outdoor activities where a robust, modular load carriage system is needed.

Q: How should I clean and maintain the rig?

A: Clean with a damp cloth and mild soap, air dry away from heat, and regularly check straps and stitching. Avoid machine washing and harsh chemicals to preserve material and fittings.

Tip: Choose the correct size and adjust the rig for a secure, comfortable fit; consider browsing compatible pouches and accessories to build a setup tailored to your tactical, duty or outdoor needs.
