Main features

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the badge on a jacket or hat for commemorative display, or mount it in a shadow box for a collection. It works well as a historical piece for Alpini enthusiasts and military collectors.

In most cases, collectors keep the badge safe in a display case or attach it with a secure fastener for short-term wear. It is also appropriate as a respectful gift for veterans or history-minded buyers interested in tactical or military memorabilia.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves the enamel and metal finish; handle gently to avoid scratching.

- Clean with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Store in a dry place away from prolonged moisture and direct sunlight to prevent discoloration.
- Small variations or minor surface imperfections may occur due to the enamel process.
- Availability is limited; items are produced or offered in small quantities.

Q: What are the exact dimensions of the badge?

A: It is made of enameled metal, offering a durable surface and detailed colored finish suitable for display and careful wear.

Q: Which medals or decorations are shown on the badge?

A: The badge reproduces two Gold Medals for Military Valour (Greece and Russia), three Silver Medals for Military Valour (Assaba, Ettangi 1913; Pal Grande, Pal Piccolo, Frekofel 1914) and one Silver Army Valour Medal for the Friuli earthquake relief in 1976.

Q: What does the hand gripping the rock represent?

A: The hand gripping the rock symbolizes the Alpini's strength and resistance in mountain terrain—an emblem of determination and the unit's alpine heritage.

Q: Can I wear this badge on a uniform or tactical jacket?

A: Yes, many buyers use it for commemorative wear on jackets or hats; however, consider local uniform rules if you intend to wear it on official service attire.

Q: Is this item suitable for collectors and military surplus shoppers?

A: Yes. It is aimed at collectors, history enthusiasts, and military surplus buyers looking for a commemorative Alpini insignia with historical references.
