## Product overview

The **Distintivo Gruppo Conegliano 3° Reggimento Artiglieria Montagna** is a commemorative



metal badge for collectors, veterans, reenactors and anyone interested in military surplus, tactical or duty memorabilia. It reproduces the original unit insignia and is suitable for display or wearing on alpine hats and similar garments.

Definition: this is a silvered, browned metal pin badge featuring an eagle clutching the 75/13 mortar, surrounded by the circular inscription **GRUPPO CONEGLIANO 3° REGGIMENTO ARTIGLIERIA MONTAGNA**.

### Main features

Well-crafted and historically styled, the badge combines durable materials with fine engraving for a faithful reproduction of the original insignia.

- **Design:** Eagle with outstretched wings clutching the 75/13 mortar, encircled by the unit name.
- **Materials:** Silvered, browned metal with finely incised details and enamel elements.
- **Additional details:** Enamel panel marked **JULIA** and a light-blue ribbon showing two gold medals for Military Valour (campaigns in Greece and Russia).
- **Attachment:** Rear pin fastener for secure wear on hats or garments.
- **Size:** 2.2 cm wide x 2.8 cm high — compact but clearly visible.
- **Suitability:** Ideal for collectors, historical displays, and ceremonial or commemorative wear.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear it on alpine hats, attach it to jackets or display it in a collection case. The rear pin makes mounting quick and secure.

In most cases, this badge is used for historical display, collection, or commemorative purposes rather than as an active-duty insignia. It is also suitable for tactical and police memorabilia collections that focus on mountain artillery history.

### Care and notes

Keep the badge in good condition with simple care and mindful handling; its metal finish and enamel are durable but benefit from basic maintenance.

- Store dry and avoid prolonged exposure to moisture to protect the finish.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals.
- Fasten the pin carefully to prevent fabric damage.
- Availability is limited—this piece is sought after by collectors.

**Q:** What are the exact dimensions of the badge?



**A:** The badge measures 2.2 cm in width and 2.8 cm in height. It is compact enough for hats yet large enough to show the engraved details.

**Q:** What material is the badge made from?

**A:** It is made of silvered, browned metal with finely incised detailing and enamel accents, designed to be durable for display and wear.

**Q:** How do I attach the badge?

**A:** The badge uses a rear pin fastener. Attach it to a hat or garment by pushing the pin through fabric and securing the clasp on the inside.

**Q:** What does the design represent?

**A:** The design shows an eagle clutching the 75/13 mortar, surrounded by the unit name, symbolizing the unit's mountain artillery heritage and operational role.

**Q:** Is this an officially issued military insignia?

**A:** This item is a commemorative badge reflecting the historical insignia of the unit. It is intended for collectors, display, and commemorative use rather than as an active duty authorization.

**Q:** Is the badge still in production and easy to buy?
