Product overview

The Distintivo Battaglione Alpini L'Aquila is an enameled metal badge that represents the identity and tradition of the Alpini battalion based in L'Aquila. It is suitable for collectors, military surplus shoppers, reenactors, and anyone who wants a compact emblem of Alpine military heritage.



Definition: a small enameled metal badge (cm 2.3 L x 3 H) featuring an eagle, snowy mountains, the city coat of arms and the motto by Gabriele d'Annunzio.

Main features

Clear, durable design and compact size make this badge easy to wear or display.

- **Prominent eagle motif:** Eagle in flight with outstretched claws on a sky-blue background.
- **Alpine scene:** Snowy mountains in the background symbolizing the battalion's operating environment.
- **City crest:** Heraldic coat of arms of the city of L'Aquila at the upper right.
- **Historical motto:** Includes Gabriele d'Annunzio's motto "D'Aquila penne, ugne di leonessa."
- **Material:** Enameled metal construction.

How to use / When it's useful

Use the badge as a uniform accessory, display piece, or part of a military surplus collection. It works well on jackets, bags, display boards and in collectors' cases when you want a small, identifiable emblem.

Quick answer: it is best used as a wearable emblem or collectible display item. In most cases, collectors, reenactors and duty or police surplus buyers choose this kind of badge for its symbolic value and compact size.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves the enamel and metal finish; handle gently to avoid chips or scratches.

- Clean with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners and strong solvents.
- Store separately to prevent scratching or enamel damage.
- Handle carefully—enameled surfaces can chip if dropped or struck.
- Availability may be limited due to demand; purchase promptly if needed.

FAQ

Q: What are the badge dimensions?

A: The badge measures 2.3 cm wide by 3 cm high. It is compact and designed for everyday wear or display.

Q: What material is the badge made of?



A: The badge is made of enameled metal. The finish gives color and protection but should be handled with care to avoid chips.

Q: What does the motto mean?

A: The motto "D'Aquila penne, ugne di leonessa" was written by Gabriele d'Annunzio and evokes the majesty of the eagle and the pride of the lioness. It is a poetic reference tied to the unit's identity.

Q: Can I wear this badge every day?

A: Yes. Its compact size and sturdy enameled metal make it suitable for regular wear, but follow care notes to preserve the finish.

Q: Is this item suitable for military surplus or tactical collections?

A: Yes. Collectors of military surplus, tactical gear and duty or police memorabilia often include unit badges like this for historical and display purposes.

Q: How do I buy the badge?

A: Add the item to your cart on the product page to complete the purchase. Note that availability can be limited, so ordering promptly is recommended.
