The Fascetta Metallo LOMBARDIA 2004 is a bronzed metal identification band created to commemorate the seismic events that affected the province of Brescia in November 2004 (DPCM 07/02/2008). It is aimed at collectors, historians, and anyone interested in military surplus, tactical memorabilia, or duty/police-related keepsakes.



Definition: This is a bronzed metal band engraved "Lombardia 2004" with foldable side tabs for attachment.

Main features

Quality construction and a discreet design make this fascetta suitable for display or attachment to equipment and collections.

- **Material:** Bronzed metal for a durable, classic finish.
- **Engraving:** Precisely engraved with "Lombardia 2004".
- **Dimensions:** 38 mm length x 7 mm height.
- **Attachment:** Foldable side tabs for secure fixing to various supports.
- **Historical reference:** Linked to seismic events in the Brescia province (November 2004, DPCM 07/02/2008).

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: Use the foldable side tabs to attach the fascetta to straps, gear, or display mounts; it works well as a collector's item or a commemorative tag. In most cases, a small hand tool or light pressure will fold the tabs to hold the band in place.

It is useful for collectors of military surplus, tactical or police memorabilia, museums, or personal remembrance displays. The compact size and simple attachment method make it easy to integrate with existing gear or exhibits.

Care and notes

Basic care ensures the finish and engraving remain clear over time.

- Wipe with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Store in a dry place to reduce tarnishing of the bronzed finish.
- Handle tabs gently when folding to avoid bending beyond intended angle.
- Availability is limited; orders may require submission of the requested attestazione via the site contact function.

FAQ

Q: What are the dimensions of the Fascetta Metallo LOMBARDIA 2004?

A: The fascetta measures 38 mm in length and 7 mm in height. These compact dimensions suit display or attachment to small straps and tags.

Q: What material is the band made from?



A: It is made of bronzed metal, providing a durable, classic appearance while protecting the engraved text.

Q: How do I attach the fascetta?

A: The fascetta has foldable side tabs; fold them around the support (strap, bracket, or mount) to secure the band. Apply steady, controlled pressure to fold the tabs.

Q: Can I order more than one fascetta?

A: Yes, multiple units can be ordered, subject to current stock levels. Note that availability is limited and demand may be high.

Q: Why does the listing refer to November 2004 and DPCM 07/02/2008?

A: The engraving and reference mark the seismic events in the province of Brescia (November 2004) and the related administrative decision (DPCM 07/02/2008) for historical context.
