The **Medaglia Artide Antartide e Ricerca di Alta Valenza Scientifica** is a commemorative medal for military and civilian personnel of the Difesa who served in high-value scientific research missions in polar regions. It is intended for service members, uniformed staff, and collectors who want an official token of recognition for Arctic and Antarctic research duty.

Definition: this is a silvered metal commemorative medal awarded for participation in scientific missions in the Arctic, Antarctic and similar high-value research operations. It also suits military, tactical and duty uniform displays and military surplus collections.

Main features

Key physical and award details of the medal at a glance:

- **Material:** silvered metal.
- **Diameter:** 40 mm.
- **Weight:** approximately 25 grams.
- **Reverse inscription:** "PRO SCIENTIAE PRERVESTIGATIONE" (emphasizing scientific research).
- **Ribbon:** 37 mm wide, vertical stripes in violet, white, black, white, red representing polar environment and aurora.

How to use / When it's useful

Wear the medal on the appropriate service or ceremonial uniform as prescribed by your unit or organization, or keep it in a display case as part of a military or tactical memorabilia collection. It serves as a visible recognition of participation and dedication to scientific missions in extreme environments.

Quick answer: the medal is awarded after a total of 30 days served in qualifying Arctic, Antarctic or other high-value scientific missions. In most cases, recipients will wear it at formal events, parades, and official ceremonies or include it in a curated military surplus collection.

Care and notes

Basic care will keep the medal presentable for display or wear. Store it dry and handle it with simple cleaning methods to preserve finish and inscription.

- Clean with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals.
- Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight to protect the ribbon colors.
- Available only in the 37 mm format—check uniform regulations before purchase.
- Limited quantities may be available; consider this when planning replacements for duty or



displays.

FAQ

Q: Who can receive the Medaglia Artide Antartide e Ricerca di Alta Valenza Scientifica?

A: The medal is granted to military and civilian personnel of the Difesa who have participated in qualifying scientific research missions in the Arctic, Antarctic or other high-value research operations for a cumulative period of 30 days.

Q: What are the dimensions and weight of the medal?

A: The medal measures 40 mm in diameter and weighs approximately 25 grams. The ribbon width is 37 mm.

Q: What does the motto on the back mean?

A: The inscription "PRO SCIENTIAE PRERVESTIGATIONE" highlights the importance of scientific investigation and research; it underscores the medal's connection to scientific missions.

Q: What colors are on the ribbon and what do they represent?

A: The ribbon displays vertical stripes in violet, white, black, white and red, chosen to evoke the polar environment and the aurora typically seen in those regions.

Q: Is the medal available in different sizes or formats?

A: No, this commemorative medal is offered only in the 37 mm format, as noted in the product details.

Q: How is eligibility for the medal determined?

A: Eligibility is based on documented service: recipients must have completed a cumulative 30 days in qualifying research missions. Confirm eligibility through your unit or Difesa administrative channels.

Tip: Choose the correct 37 mm format for uniform wear and consider browsing related commemorative medals and military surplus items to complete a uniform or display without delay.
