Product overview

The Fregio Ricamato CIMIC for Sottufficiali di Corpo is an embroidered corps badge designed for



non-commissioned officers to wear on the male stiff berretto. It is intended for military personnel and collectors who need an authentic-looking CIMIC (Civil-Military Cooperation) emblem for formal uniforms, ceremonial use, or replacement on duty equipment.

Definition: a CIMIC embroidered badge is a cloth emblem showing the Civil-Military Cooperation symbol and traditional military motifs, made to fit the male stiff berretto. This badge suits tactical, military surplus, and duty/uniform needs where a formal emblem is required.

Main features

Carefully crafted with traditional design elements, this embroidered CIMIC fregio combines visual detail and durable materials to remain presentable on formal headgear.

- **Blue cloth base:** high-quality blue fabric chosen for durability and the traditional look of the Sottufficiali di Corpo role.
- **Gold canutiglia embroidery:** metal-thread embroidery (canutiglia) for a bright, long-lasting finish and a formal appearance.
- **Central flaming grenade:** classic military symbol representing strength and readiness, placed at the center of the badge.
- **Crossed bronze cannons:** historic artillery motif with muzzles upward and breeches down, adding tradition and prestige.
- **Trophy of arms details:** crossed lances with pennons, sabres, rifles, and lightning bolts to symbolize defense, combat readiness, and rapid action.
- **Artisanal craftsmanship:** hand-finished embroidery and attention to iconographic detail for a refined uniform accessory.

How to use / When it's useful

This fregio is meant to be applied to the male stiff berretto as part of formal uniform dress or used as a replacement emblem for regimental headgear. It complements duty and ceremonial uniforms and is suitable for service, training displays, and historical/museum displays.

Quick answer: use it on the berretto rigido maschile for formal occasions or when replacing a worn badge. In most cases, a trained tailorshop or uniform maintenance team will attach it to ensure correct positioning and secure fit.

Care and notes

To keep the badge looking its best, handle the embroidered canutiglia with care and avoid abrasive cleaning methods that could damage the metal thread.

- Store flat or in a protective case to prevent crushing the embroidery.
- Do not machine wash; spot clean gently with a soft cloth and mild detergent if needed.
- Avoid solvents, bleach, or aggressive cleaners that can dull the gold thread.



- If uncertain, consult a professional uniform cleaner for safe maintenance.

FAQ

Q: What materials are used in this fregio?

A: The badge is made on a high-quality blue cloth base with gold canutiglia metal-thread embroidery and detailed stitched elements for the grenade, cannons, and trophy of arms.

Q: Is this fregio authentic to Italian military appearance?

A: The design follows the traditional iconography and appearance used for CIMIC NCO badges and is produced to match the traditional look used by Italian forces.

Q: How is the fregio attached to the berretto rigido maschile?

A: Attachment is typically done by a tailor or uniform maintenance staff to ensure correct placement and a secure fit; methods may include sewing or approved uniform attachment techniques.

Q: Can I wear this badge on other items besides the berretto?

A: While designed for the male stiff berretto, it can be applied to other uniform pieces or display items if done in accordance with dress regulations and careful mounting.

Q: How should I clean and maintain the canutiglia embroidery?

A: Spot clean gently with a damp cloth and mild detergent, avoid machine washing and harsh chemicals, and consider professional cleaning for persistent stains to protect the metal thread.

Q: Do you ship inside Italy and how is the fregio packaged?

A: The fregio is packaged in protective wrapping to preserve shape and finish during transit; shipping options and times depend on the retailer's delivery services within Italy.
