Product overview



The Knight of the Order of Malta Set with Swords is a three-piece ceremonial set made for members, collectors and history enthusiasts who value tradition and formal insignia. It includes a large enamel ceremonial cross, a smaller cross for gala uniform, and a lapel rosette for civilian wear.

Definition: this is a ceremonial insignia set representing the Sovereign Military Order of Malta (SMOM), designed for formal use, uniform display and private collection. Useful in contexts from military surplus collections to tactical, duty and police dress displays.

Main features

High-quality enamel and metal construction with a classic knightly design and crossed-sword detail, supplied only as a complete set.

- **Three-piece set:** large ceremonial cross, small uniform cross, and lapel rosette for civilian suits.
- **Material:** high-quality enameled metal for both crosses, with a polished finish.
- **Ceremonial design:** the large cross is sized for formal wear; the smaller cross fits gala uniforms without weighing them down.
- **Rosette:** refined civilian design with red-and-white border to match the Order of Malta colors.
- **Symbolism:** crossed swords signify defense of the faith, duty, courage and loyalty.
- **Durability:** solid construction intended to retain appearance with proper care.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the large cross at formal ceremonies, use the smaller cross on gala uniforms, and pin the rosette to civilian jackets for everyday recognition. The set is also suitable for display or as a collector's item.

In most cases, members will use the set during Order events; collectors will keep it with other military surplus or ceremonial pieces, and historians or police/duty uniform enthusiasts will display it as part of a formal dress or memorabilia collection.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves finish and detail: store in the protective box, avoid harsh chemicals, and handle enamel surfaces with care.

- Keep dry and avoid prolonged exposure to moisture to protect the enamel and metal.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners; wipe gently with a soft cloth.
- Store in the original protective box to prevent scratches and maintain presentation.
- Sold only as a complete set; individual elements are not available separately.
- Availability may require documentation in some cases; processing usually begins within 2–3



business days after payment confirmation.

FAQ

Q: What materials are the large and small crosses made of?

A: Both crosses are made of enameled metal with a polished finish, designed for visual durability and ceremonial use.

Q: Can non-members buy this set?

A: Yes. Collectors and enthusiasts may purchase the set, though some purchases may require documentation depending on local rules or seller policy.

Q: How long does delivery take?

A: Orders are usually processed within 2–3 business days after payment confirmation; final delivery time varies by destination and shipping choice.

Q: Is this an authentic product of the Order of Malta?

A: The crossed swords are a traditional symbol of defense, courage and service, reflecting the historical and ceremonial values of the Order of Malta.
