The Enamelled Metal Badge of the 2° Asiago Mountain Artillery Group is a collectible emblem for



military history enthusiasts, collectors of military surplus, and those interested in alpine artillery units. Definition: it is a metal, enamel-finished lapel-style badge representing the 2° Asiago Artiglieria Montagna unit.

This badge recalls the post-war Italian alpine artillery tradition tied to the Gruppo Artiglieria Montagna "Asiago" (active 1952–1991). It suits display, private collections, and historical study rather than official duty or police use.

### Main features

Simple, durable construction with historical symbolism and clear measurements—designed for collectors and display.

- **Unit:** 2° Asiago, Gruppo Artiglieria Montagna (Brigata Tridentina affiliation).
- **Material:** enameled metal for color durability and a refined finish.
- **Design:** mule and handler motif with snowy mountain background, symbolizing alpine artillery transport and terrain.

It is also appropriate for historical exhibits, private study, and thematic collections related to military surplus, tactical history, or police and duty memorabilia.

### Care and notes

Keep the badge as a collectible item and follow basic care to preserve finish and detail.

- Wipe gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive cleaners and harsh chemicals.
- Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent color fading.
- Handle by the edges to reduce fingerprints and wear on the enamel.
- Note: this is a commemorative/collectible emblem and not an official, certified item for active duty use.
