The Pulce da Basco 84° Fanteria "Venezia" is a small beret badge made for collectors,



reenactors, uniform restorers and anyone who wants to honor the history of the 84° Reggimento Fanteria "Venezia". It is suitable for display, historic uniforms and military surplus collections.

Definition: a convex, silver-plated metal beret badge with the number "84" in black enamel, designed to fit the infantry beret insignia. This item is a historical reproduction and a collector's accessory for military and tactical gear enthusiasts.

### Main features

Simple, durable design that reproduces the traditional infantry beret pulce with clear regiment identification.

- **Diameter:** 10 mm
- **Material:** silver-plated metal, convex
- **Detail:** number "84" in black enamel for high contrast
- **Finish:** glossy
- **Attachment:** side tabs to insert into the infantry beret insignia (fregio)
- **Uses:** collector's piece, uniform restoration, historical reenactment

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: insert the side tabs into the matching slot on the infantry beret insignia for a secure fit. The pulce is designed to integrate with standard infantry beret fregi used for historic uniforms.

In most cases, this pulce is used by collectors, reenactors or museums to complete period uniforms or displays. It is also suitable as a small accent for military surplus and tactical gear collections.

### Care and notes

Basic care keeps the badge looking its best and preserves the finish for display or wear.

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth to remove dust and fingerprints.
- Avoid abrasive cleaners or strong chemicals that could damage the silver plating or enamel.
- Keep away from children due to small size and choking risk.
- Store in a dry place to reduce tarnishing and preserve the glossy finish.

### FAQ

**Q:** Is this pulce an original military-issued item?

**A:** It is produced to traditional specifications and reproduces the original badge design. It is offered as a faithful historical reproduction suitable for collectors.



**Q:** How is the pulce fixed to the beret badge (fregio)?

**A:** The pulce has side tabs that slide into the corresponding openings on the infantry fregio for a stable fit.

**Q:** What are the exact dimensions?

**A:** The pulce has a diameter of 10 mm; the compact size makes it suitable for standard beret insignia.
