## Product short description:

Official rubber patch of the GIS - Gruppo di Intervento Speciale Carabinieri, intended for Arma personnel and authorized collectors. Backed with rear Velcro for easy attachment to uniforms or equipment.

- **Material:** Durable rubber with high-definition detailing.
- **Design:** Shield depicting the Arma grenade above a gladius, a parachute and two outstretched wings — symbols of strength, precision and rapid action.
- **Attachment:** Rear Velcro backing for secure, removable mounting.
- **Size:** Diameter 7 cm.
- **Sale:** Reserved for Arma personnel or authorized collectors; sale subject to document verification. Complies with applicable regulations.

## Product overview

The Patch Gommato GIS Gruppo Intervento Speciale Carabinieri is a professional 3D rubber



identification patch made for active Carabinieri operators and authorised collectors. It reproduces the GIS emblem on a low-reflective black background with ocre/sand details and a sewn Velcro backing for secure attachment to tactical gear.

Definition: a high-density PVC rubber tactical patch, shaped in 3D relief, intended for operational use by authorised personnel and for sale to collectors with the required licence. Suitable for tactical, military surplus and duty/police equipment applications.

### Main features

This patch combines durable materials and practical design for operational use on softshells, tactical vests and approved equipment.

- **Material:** high-density PVC polymer with 3D molded rubber relief.
- **Finish:** matte black base with ocre/sand color accents and anti-fade surface treatment.
- **Size:** 7 cm diameter, approx. 4 mm thick.
- **Attachment:** industrially sewn Velcro backing compatible with standard patch loop panels.
- **Durability:** resistant to wear, abrasion, moisture and extreme temperatures; waterproof construction.
- **Design:** emblem shows grenade, gladius, parachute and wings to reflect unit identity and airborne capability.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: attach the patch to a Velcro panel on your softshell, tactical vest, jacket or approved bag; the sewn Velcro holds during dynamic operations and training. In most cases, the patch is used on operational kit rather than on dress uniforms.

Use the patch when you need a durable, low-reflective unit identifier during duty, training, close-quarters work or field operations. It is designed for professionals and for licensed collectors who follow legal and internal rules for wearing or displaying unit insignia.

### Care and notes

Simple care keeps the patch functional and readable; follow these handling and compliance notes.

- Wipe clean with a damp cloth; avoid strong solvents or abrasive cleaners.
- Store flat or attached to gear to prevent deformation; avoid prolonged exposure to direct heat sources.
- Sale reserved to active Carabinieri personnel and collectors with valid prefectural licence (Art. 28 T.U.L.P.S.); purchase requires document verification.
- Do not use the patch publicly in contexts that could violate laws on misuse of military insignia; improper use may be subject to legal restrictions.



## FAQ

**Q:** Who can buy the GIS patch?

**A:** Only active Carabinieri personnel and collectors holding a valid prefectural licence (Art. 28 T.U.L.P.S.) may purchase this item. Document checks are mandatory before sale.

**Q:** Is this patch suitable for operational use?

**A:** Yes. It is made from high-density PVC rubber with a matte, low-reflective finish and a sewn Velcro backing intended for field and tactical use.

**Q:** Can the patch be customised or personalised?

**A:** No. For reasons of conformity and unit identity, this patch is not available for personalisation or modification.

**Q:** How do I submit documents for verification?

**A:** Verification documents (service ID copy or command attestation, or valid collector licence) must be uploaded via the site's contact form or provided during the verification step after registration.

**Q:** Where can the patch be delivered?

**A:** Delivery to the buyer's command address is recommended to protect confidentiality and ensure traceability. Personal addresses may be accepted after verification, depending on rules.

**Q:** How long does the verification process take?

**A:** Verification is normally completed within a few working hours after receiving all required documents, but times may vary depending on completeness and business hours.

**Tip:** Choose the correct variant and ensure your verification documents are ready before registering. Browse related tactical and military surplus patches to complete your kit or collection without compromising compliance.
