The Vega Holster IA260 is a professional ambidextrous holster in black Cordura designed for law enforcement, security professionals, plainclothes officers and authorized civilian carriers who need a discreet, reliable carry solution. It supports both inside-the-waistband and outside-the-



waistband carry and is built for tactical, duty and police use as well as military surplus enthusiasts.

Definition: a semi-rigid, thermoformed Cordura Dupont® 1000 Denier holster that offers 4-in-1 carry options (inside/outside, left/right) for secure and fast one-handed draw. Made in Italy with controlled production and quality checks.

Main features

Compact, ambidextrous design with robust materials and professional attachment options for stable, discreet carry.

- **4-in-1 configuration** — inside waistband (IWB) and outside waistband (OWB), left- and right-handed setup.
- **Cordura Dupont® 1000 Denier** — high abrasion resistance, lightweight and weather-resistant textile.
- **Semi-rigid thermoformed shell** — passive retention for secure but rapid one-handed extraction.
- **Attachment system** — Velcro pass-through and high-strength technopolymer clip for firm belt grip.
- **Low-profile black finish** — matte look for discreet plainclothes or uniform use.
- **Compatibility** — shaped for many semi-automatic pistols such as Beretta 92/96/98, Beretta Compact 4¼", Beretta 90 Two, Colt 1911/Government, S&W 1911, Springfield 1911 A1, Tanfoglio Force, Taurus PT92/99/100/101.

How to use / When it's useful

Use the IA260 configured inside the waistband for concealed carry or outside for faster access; switch sides easily for left- or right-handed draw. The adjustable pass-through and clip allow integration with service belts, leather belts, or civilian belts for patrols, plainclothes work, or routine duty.

Quick answer: set the holster to IWB for discreet concealment or OWB for quicker presentation. In most cases, the thermoformed shell and passive retention provide a stable platform during movement, vehicle duty, or prolonged wear.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the holster functional and extends service life; follow these simple precautions and compatibility checks before use.

- Clean with a soft brush or damp cloth and mild soap; avoid solvents or aggressive chemicals.
- Verify fit with your specific pistol model before operational use; consult the listed compatible



models.

- Check attachment points and stitching regularly for wear, especially after heavy use.
- Sold for general purchase but recommended for authorized or professional carriers only.

FAQ

Q: Is this holster compatible with Glock or Sig Sauer pistols?

A: No. The IA260 is shaped for specific models such as Beretta, Colt 1911 variants, Taurus PT92, Tanfoglio and similar pistols. Check the compatibility list before buying.

Q: Can I use the IA260 with a regular jeans belt?

A: Yes. The holster fits standard civilian belts and widened service belts thanks to the adjustable pass-through and clip system.

Q: Is the holster rigid or soft?

A: It is semi-rigid: the Cordura is thermoformed to keep shape and provide passive retention while remaining lighter and more comfortable than hard polymer holsters.

Q: Is the holster reversible for left- and right-handed users?

A: Yes. The IA260 has an ambidextrous architecture that you can configure for left- or right-handed carry without buying a second holster.

Q: Is this holster suitable for daily carry?

A: Yes. It is designed for prolonged wear and frequent use, with materials and construction intended for daily operational duty and plainclothes assignments.

Q: Do I need a firearms permit to buy this holster?

A: The holster is sold freely, but its use should be limited to authorized personnel and lawful, licensed firearm owners according to local regulations.

Tip: Choose the correct configuration (IWB vs OWB and left vs right) for your primary carry setup and check the pistol compatibility list before purchase; consider browsing related tactical belts, magazine pouches and duty gear to complete a balanced carry system.
