Product short description:

The Distintivo in Metallo “Caduti per la Patria” is the official Italian remembrance badge for military and ceremonial use, designed to be worn on uniforms during commemorations. It offers a solemn tribute to the fallen of all wars and peace missions.

- **Material:** Metal badge, diameter 24 mm.
- **Design:** Depicts the Myosotis (blue forget-me-not), symbol of eternal remembrance; the five petals evoke the Stella d'Italia.
- **Use:** Intended for wear during commemorations on 2 and 4 November and 11 and 12 November, or for ceremonial display.
- **Availability:** Available to collectors holding a prefectural (prefettura) license.
- **Note:** A historically meaningful emblem to wear with honor or preserve respectfully.

Product description:

Product overview

The Distintivo Metallo Caduti per la Patria is a metal commemorative badge intended for Italian



military personnel, reservists, veterans and licensed collectors who wish to honor fallen service members. It is a formal emblem worn on service uniforms and recognized for commemorative ceremonies.

Definition: a 24 mm enamel metal badge featuring the Myosotis ("forget-me-not") flower, adopted as a national symbol of remembrance by Italian armed forces and related groups.

Main features

Compact, durable and designed for formal uniform use, the badge combines symbolic detail with military-grade finishing suitable for duty and ceremonial wear.

- Material: high-quality enamel metal with a glossy, long-lasting finish.
- Appearance: stylized Myosotis flower in Italy blue with a gold center.
- Size: diameter 24 mm.
- Shape: round with a shaped border following the flower profile.
- Fastening: pin with rear clutch, designed for the left collar of the jacket.
- Adoption: proposed by the Gruppo Medaglie d'Oro al Valore Militare d'Italia and used as a commemorative emblem by the Forces.
- Compatible with EI, MM, AM, CC and GdF uniforms and suitable for collectors in military surplus and tactical/police contexts (where permitted).

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear this badge on the left collar of the jacket during official commemorative days. It adds a respectful, visible sign of remembrance during ceremonies and national observances.

In most cases, the badge is authorized by the Ministry of Defence for specific commemorative dates (2 November, 4 November, 11 November and 12 November). Civilians and collectors must follow purchase regulations and present the required prefectural license (ex art. 28 TULPS) where applicable.

Care and notes

Simple care preserves enamel detail and the finish; follow the notes below and respect legal requirements for purchase and wear.

- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid abrasive materials and chemical solvents.
- Attach securely to the left collar; check the clutch before wearing to prevent loss.
- Metal version is subject to sale regulations; civilians and collectors need the prefectural license ex art. 28 TULPS when required.
- Wear the badge only on authorized commemorative days and according to uniform protocol.



FAQ

Q: Is the badge wearable only by military personnel?

A: The metal badge is intended for military personnel, reservists and veterans. Collectors may buy it if they hold the required prefectural license (ex art. 28 TULPS).

Q: Do civilians need a license to purchase?

A: Yes. Civilian buyers and private collectors must provide the prefectural license ex art. 28 TULPS when purchasing the metal version.

Q: When can the badge be worn?

A: The badge is worn during official commemorative days such as 2 Nov, 4 Nov, 11 Nov and 12 Nov. Use follows Ministry of Defence authorization for these dates.

Q: Where on the uniform is it placed?

A: The badge is applied to the left collar of the jacket, centered and clearly visible, following standard uniform protocol.

Q: Is this an official commemorative emblem?

A: Yes. The badge was proposed by the Gruppo Medaglie d'Oro al Valore Militare d'Italia and is used as a formal symbol of remembrance by the armed forces.

Q: Can this badge be given as a commemorative gift?

A: Yes. It is suitable as an institutional or commemorative gift, provided the recipient and giver comply with applicable purchase and wear regulations.
