Fabric badge "Caduti per la Patria", the official Italian memorial emblem. Suitable for veterans, serving personnel, collectors and institutions to wear or display during commemorative ceremonies.

- **Material:** Fabric badge, 45 mm diameter, with pin fastening.
- **Design:** Depicts the Myosotis (forget-me-not), a symbol of eternal memory, fidelity and love.
- **Use:** Wear on uniform during commemorative days (2 and 4 November; 11 and 12 November) or keep as a ceremonial/collectible item.
- **Approval:** Product approved by the Gruppo Medaglie d'Oro al Valor Militare.
- **Availability:** Sold on Tutto Militare and available to authorized collectors; a respectful emblem to keep and wear.

Product description:



Product overview

The Caduti per la Patria fabric badge is a ceremonial cloth pin intended for Italian Armed Forces personnel, veterans and licensed collectors. It honors the memory of those fallen in war and in international peace missions and is used for official commemorations and formal civilian dress days.

Definition: a 45 mm embroidered Myosotis (Forget?Me?Not) fabric badge with a metal rear pin, adopted on the initiative of the Gruppo Medaglie d'Oro al Valor Militare d'Italia as a symbol of collective remembrance. Suitable for military, tactical, military surplus collectors and duty or police ceremonial wear.

Main features

Quality embroidered fabric, faithful colors and clear styling provide visibility and comfort for ceremonial use.

- **Material:** durable high-quality fabric with professional embroidery.
- **Color:** Italian blue (azzurro Italia) with a gold center, faithful to the original model.
- **Size:** 45 mm diameter (larger than the metal version).
- **Fastening:** metal rear pin for easy application and removal.
- **Placement:** intended for the left lapel (bavero sinistro) of civilian dress, per protocol.
- **Symbolism:** Myosotis flower representing memory, fidelity and the link between the Nation and its fallen.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear it on the left lapel of civilian dress during authorized commemorative days and official ceremonies. In most cases, active service members, veterans and licensed collectors may wear this badge according to current rules.

Common occasions include commemorations such as 2 November (All Souls), 4 November (National Unity and Armed Forces Day), 11 November (Veterans Day) and 12 November (Remembrance of military and civilian fallen in international missions). The badge is designed for visible ceremonial use rather than everyday duty wear.

Care and notes

Store and handle the fabric badge to preserve its color and shape; follow basic care guidelines below.

- Store in a rigid box in a dry place to avoid creasing or damage.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight and excess humidity to prevent fading.
- Do not wash in a machine or dry clean; clean with a dry or slightly damp cloth only.



- Civilians and collectors must hold a licenza prefettizia ex art. 28 TULPS where required for ownership or display.

FAQ

Q: Who can wear this badge?

A: Active military personnel may wear it on authorized days. Veterans and reservists may also wear it, and civilians may wear it only if they hold the required prefectoral license.

Q: What is the difference between the fabric and metal versions?

A: The fabric version is 45 mm and designed for ceremonial visibility and comfort; the metal version is smaller (24 mm) and more discreet for everyday or compact use.

Q: Is this an official emblem?

A: Yes. The fabric badge was adopted following the initiative of the Gruppo Medaglie d'Oro al Valor Militare d'Italia and is used in commemorative and ceremonial contexts.

Q: Do civilians need a license to purchase?

A: Yes. Civilians and collectors are required to obtain a licenza prefettizia ex art. 28 TULPS where applicable. Check local rules before purchase.

Q: How is the badge attached to clothing?

A: The badge uses a metal rear pin that allows easy application and removal; it is intended for the left lapel of civilian dress as per protocol.

Q: Can I buy this online?

A: The badge is commonly offered by military surplus and commemorative retailers. When buying online, verify seller credentials and any required licensing for civilians.

Tip: Choose the fabric (45 mm) for visible ceremonial use or the metal (24 mm) for a discreet option; check licensing requirements if you are a civilian and browse related commemorative and military surplus items to complete a respectful display.
