Official patch of the Raggruppamento Carabinieri Investigazioni Scientifiche (RaCIS), for authorized personnel and licensed collectors. Identifies staff involved in forensic analysis of DNA, fingerprints, ballistics and crime-scene work, and is designed for application on an operational suit.

- **Design:** Red background showing a microscope over the Carabinieri flame and the institutional "RR".
- **Size:** 9 cm diameter.
- **Backing:** No Velcro backing; intended for direct attachment to a suit.

Product overview



The Patch Carabinieri Investigazioni Scientifiche is an official round embroidered badge made for Carabinieri personnel assigned to forensic and scientific investigations. It is designed for the tuta operativa (tuta OP) and for authorized collectors who hold the required license.

Definition: a 9 cm embroidered identification patch that visually identifies members of the Raggruppamento Carabinieri Investigazioni Scientifiche. Useful for tactical, duty and police uniform configurations where clear unit ID is required.

Main features

Clear, durable and regulation-aware design built for operational use and long-term wear.

- **Round embroidered patch**, diameter 9 cm for good readability at distance.
- **Red textile background** with yellow, grey and black stitched details for high contrast.
- **High-density embroidery** using resistant polyester thread to withstand frequent washing and abrasion.
- **Primary sewn application** for a permanent fit; a velcro-backed option is also offered in the product menu.
- **No velcro by default** to reduce bulk and risk of accidental detachment during active duty.
- **Robust edge finish** to limit fraying and preserve shape in intensive use.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: the patch is intended to be permanently sewn onto the operational jacket or designated textile panels of the tuta OP, in the positions indicated by unit rules (sleeve, chest or panel).

In most cases, operators wear it to show official membership in RaCIS during scene-of-crime work, lab duties and when providing technical support to the judicial authority. It also helps other forces and institutional partners recognise technical-science personnel quickly.

Care and notes

Simple care and operational notes to keep the patch readable and compliant.

- Wash as part of the garment; embroidery and fabric are chosen for repeated laundering, but follow garment care instructions.
- Designed for sewing: a permanent application is recommended for operational use; velcro variants are available if required by the unit.
- Sale is restricted: available to active military personnel (with ID) and to collectors only with a valid licenza prefettizia ex art. 28 TULPS.
- Follow internal unit regulations for exact placement on the tuta OP and other uniform items.

FAQ



Q: Who can purchase the Patch Carabinieri Investigazioni Scientifiche?

A: Purchase is reserved to active military personnel after identity verification and to collectors who hold a valid licenza prefettizia ex art. 28 TULPS. Orders must follow the site's verification process.

Q: Is the patch available with velcro?

A: The patch is designed for sewing to ensure a permanent fit. A velcro-backed option is offered as a selectable variant in the product menu for configurations that require detachable mounting.

Q: What is the size of the patch?

A: The patch has a diameter of 9 cm, a size chosen to keep embroidered details and the "CARABINIERI INVESTIGAZIONI SCIENTIFICHE" text legible at a distance.

Q: Can I use this patch on the new tuta OP Carabinieri?

A: Yes. The patch is suitable for the tuta operativa models provided placement and application follow unit regulations and uniform rules.

Q: How do I send the documents to enable purchase?

A: After creating an account, send a copy of your service ID, a service attestation, or the prefectural license via the site's contact form as required for verification.

Q: How long does account activation take?

A: Verification times vary with request volume. The staff will check submitted documents and notify you by email once your account is authorized to buy restricted items.

Tip: Choose the correct variant (sewn or velcro) and confirm placement with your unit before ordering; browse matching items like baschi, fregi and the tuta OP to complete a consistent, regulation-compliant uniform set.
