Product short description:

The Nastrino Direttore Laboratorio di Analisi Oro RIS Carabinieri is a service ribbon for Carabinieri laboratory staff, intended for personnel qualified as Laboratory Director after the required course and Analista di Laboratorio qualification.

- **Material:** Blue fabric ribbon with a central horizontal stripe and a gold microscope device.
- **Use:** Worn to complete service and dress uniforms for authorized laboratory personnel.
- **Identification:** Indicates holders who have completed the Director course and hold the Analista di Laboratorio qualification.
- **Format:** Available in regulation size and an Elite variant; compatible with multi-ribbon mounts.
- **Compliance:** Produced in accordance with current uniform regulations.

Product description:

Product overview

The **Nastrino Direttore Laboratorio di Analisi Oro RIS Carabinieri** is a regulated ribbon insignia for qualified Carabinieri personnel who direct forensic or technical analysis laboratories. It



is intended for duty and ceremonial uniforms and for collectors of military surplus, police and tactical memorabilia who meet purchase guidelines.

Definition: a formal ribbon badge worn by holders of the Analista di Laboratorio qualification who have served as a laboratory director within the RIS or equivalent Carabinieri unit.

Main features

Clear, regulation-style design with a central gold emblem that identifies laboratory leadership and technical-forensic competence.

- **Blue fabric** produced to match uniform ribbon standards.
- **Central 2 mm horizontal stripe** as a visual demarcation of the role.
- **Round gold metal badge** at center depicting a microscope, symbolizing laboratory analysis.
- Available in **flat regulatory** format and a slightly domed **Elite** variant for ceremonial use.
- Fits single mounting with clamps or screws and can be aligned on multi-place ribbon bars.
- Designed for durability with wear-resistant metal and fabric components.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear it on the uniform when you hold or have held the role of laboratory director and possess the Analista di Laboratorio qualification; it signals technical responsibility in forensic investigations. It is suitable for duty, ceremonies and formal inspections where correct insignia are required.

In most cases, the ribbon is mounted on the standard ribbon bar or on a dedicated holder, alone or aligned with other service ribbons. For collectors and military surplus buyers, confirmation of eligibility may be requested to ensure respectful and compliant use of the insignia.

Care and notes

Simple maintenance keeps the ribbon and metal badge presentable and compliant with uniform standards.

- Avoid prolonged exposure to intense heat or direct sunlight to preserve fabric color.
- Do not use harsh detergents; clean the gold badge with a soft, dry cloth.
- Store in a dry, protected place or a uniform case when not in use.
- Purchase is recommended for active Carabinieri personnel with the proper qualification or for verified collectors; documentation may be requested.

FAQ

Q: Who is entitled to wear this ribbon?



A: It is intended for Carabinieri personnel who have completed the required specialization course, hold the Analista di Laboratorio qualification and serve or have served as a laboratory director or equivalent.

Q: Can collectors buy this nastrino?

A: Yes. Serious collectors may purchase it, but Tutto Militare or the seller may request supporting documents to ensure proper use and respect for the symbol.

Q: What is the difference between the regulatory and Elite variants?

A: The regulatory format is flat and sober for daily wear, while the Elite version is slightly domed for a more refined, three-dimensional appearance suited to ceremonial uniforms.

Q: Can I mount this ribbon on a multi-place ribbon bar?

A: Yes. The ribbon is compatible with single or multi-place metal holders and can be aligned with other ribbons according to precedence rules.

Q: Is the gold microscope badge removable?

A: The badge can be removed by taking the ribbon off its metal backing and lifting the retaining tabs; this allows maintenance or replacement while keeping correct alignment.

Q: How should I care for the nastrino?

A: Avoid abrasive cleaners, clean metal parts with a soft dry cloth, keep the ribbon dry and store uniforms in protected cases to preserve appearance and compliance.

Tip: Choose the variant that fits your needs (regulatory flat for duty or slightly domed Elite for ceremony), select the appropriate ribbon holder, and browse related insignia and ribbon bars to complete a professional, regulation-compliant uniform ensemble.
