Black plastic epaulettes for the Tuta OP Carabinieri, designed for public order duties with a low-visibility finish.

- **Material:** Black plastic base with silver braid folded three times, central silver star and bullion fringe.
- **Use:** For public order service; ensures immediate role recognition and a uniform appearance among operators.
- **Attachment:** Rear Velcro fastening for quick, stable and secure mounting on the Tuta OP Carabinieri.

Product overview



The Alamari Plastica Neri Tuta OP Carabinieri are black plastic shoulder boards designed for Carabinieri personnel assigned to public order (Ordine Pubblico) duties and for qualified collectors who meet legal requirements. They signal rank and role on the Tuta OP while keeping a low-visibility, tactical look suitable for police and duty operations.

Definition: a low-visibility, regulation-style shoulder board in rigid black plastic with a silver wire border, central silver five-point star, and rear velcro fastening.

Main features

These shoulder boards combine a discreet appearance with the recognizable symbols of the Arma for clear on-duty identification.

- **Base:** rigid black plastic for low visibility and easy cleaning.
- **Border:** silver wire folded three times forming a 3.5 cm x 2 cm rectangular frame.
- **Central emblem:** silver five-point plastic star over a black fabric strip.
- **Fringe:** silver canutiglia fringe approximately 1.2 cm long at the lower edge.
- **Size:** single shoulder board 2.5 cm wide x 5.5 cm long (pair symmetric); frontal visible area ~6 cm x 2 cm (indicative).
- **Fastening:** rear velcro surface for quick attachment and removal.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: attach the velcro-backed alamari to the prepared positions on the Tuta OP Carabinieri (new model) for on-duty identification that is less visually prominent than red-bordered models. In most cases, they are used by units that require a tactical, low-contrast uniform layout.

They are suitable for public order, crowd management, and other dynamic police or tactical duties where reduced visual contrast is preferred. The velcro system allows fast removal for laundering, replacement, or maintenance without damaging the garment.

Care and notes

Simple care keeps the alamari functional and presentable while respecting operational use and uniform rules.

- Remove alamari before machine washing the Tuta OP; do not wash them attached to the garment.
- Clean with a soft, slightly damp cloth; avoid solvents, abrasive pads, or strong detergents that can dull the silver finish.
- Reattach only when the garment is fully dry and check symmetry between right and left boards.
- The velcro allows individual replacement of worn units without altering the uniform.



FAQ

Q: Who can buy the Alamari Plastica Neri Tuta OP Carabinieri?

A: Purchases are primarily reserved for active Carabinieri personnel and for collectors who hold the required prefectural license (art. 28 TULPS), subject to identity and document verification.

Q: What documentation is needed to enable purchase?

A: Active personnel should provide a copy of their service ID or a service certificate; collectors must submit the prefectural license required by law. Documents are verified by the seller before purchase access is granted.

Q: How are the alamari attached to the uniform?

A: Each alamaro has a velcro-backed surface for secure, quick fastening to the designated spots on the Tuta OP. This allows easy removal for cleaning or replacement.

Q: Are these alamari compatible with the new Tuta OP Carabinieri model?

A: Yes. The size and velcro fastening are designed to match the standard placement on the Tuta OP (new model) for correct alignment and appearance.

Q: Can I order multiple pairs for spares?

A: Yes, purchases of multiple units are possible where permitted by internal rules. Buyers should respect any restrictions set by their unit or applicable regulations.

Q: How durable are the materials in operational use?

A: The rigid plastic base, silver wire border and plastic star provide resistance to light impacts, bending and moisture. Proper care (removal before washing, gentle cleaning) extends service life.

Tip: Choose the correct variant and check compatibility with your Tuta OP before ordering; consider adding matching rank insignia or tactical accessories to complete your duty uniform and ensure a consistent, professional appearance.
