The Nastrino Ufficiale al Merito di Savoia is the officer's ribbon of the dynastic Order (est. 1988), denoting the Officer rank and a discreet mark of merit toward Casa Savoia. Suitable for wear on uniforms and formal dress.

- **Material:** Woven ribbon in Savoia blue with a central white stripe and a gold-accented center disc.
- **Dimensions:** Regulation size 37 × 10 mm; center disc 10 mm.
- **Design:** Small gold miniature of the cross and a blue roundel bearing the initials **V.E.**.
- **Use:** For official uniform and formal attire to indicate rank and affiliation with Casa Savoia.

Product overview

The Nastrino Ufficiale al Merito di Savoia is the ribbon for the "Ufficiale" grade of the dynastic Ordine al Merito di Savoia, intended for use on ceremonial or formal dress by recipients, collectors, and institutions that observe dynastic honors. Definition: this is the official ribbon strip representing the Ufficiale rank of the Savoy Order.

Suitable for military, ceremonial and police dress, it offers a tidy, proportional appearance for



ribbon bars and medal displays and is supplied in regulation dimensions with variants for a flatter or slightly domed presentation.

Main features

Designed for clear visual recognition and correct placement in multi-ribbon arrangements.

- **Regulation size:** 37 mm width × 10 mm height.
- **Color and design:** Savoy blue field with a central vertical white stripe.
- **Centrino (miniature):** 10 mm gold cross miniature with a small blue roundel bearing the initials "V.E."
- **Finish options:** flat regulation format or slightly domed "Elite" version for enhanced presentation.
- **Mounting options:** single ribbon or fitted on a ribbon bar with clamps or screws for stable attachment.
- **Compatibility:** sized to work cleanly in multi-place ribbon mounts and medal racks.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the ribbon on the left chest above the breast pocket, mounted on a ribbon bar or holder as required by your dress code. In most cases, the ribbon is placed with other decorations to form a neat, readable medallist display.

This ribbon is useful for ceremonial uniforms, formal occasions and official representations where dynastic orders are acknowledged. Always follow the specific regulations and ceremonial customs of the organization or event when choosing placement and mounting style.

Care and notes

Basic care keeps the ribbon looking formal and preserves details such as the centrino and color contrast.

- Store in a dry, dust-free place to prevent fading and deformation.
- Mount on a proper ribbon bar using clamps or screws to keep alignment in multi-ribbon setups.
- Avoid harsh chemicals or machine washing; spot clean gently if needed.
- Follow institutional rules and ceremonial guidelines for correct wear and display.

FAQ

Q: What are the dimensions of the ribbon?

A: The ribbon measures 37 mm in width and 10 mm in height, the standard format for this Ufficiale grade ribbon.



Q: What is the correct color and design?

A: The ribbon has a Savoy blue field with a central vertical white stripe; the layout is a distinguishing element of the Order.

Q: What does the 10 mm centrino represent?

A: The centrino is a 10 mm miniature showing a gold cross with a small blue roundel at the center bearing the initials "V.E.", signifying the Order's founder.

Q: Should I choose the flat regulation format or the Elite version?

A: The flat format gives a strict, institutional look for formal contexts; the Elite slightly domed version offers a fuller visual effect suited to frequent ceremonial use.

Q: Can the ribbon be mounted on a porta nastrini or multi-place bar?

A: Yes. You can fit the ribbon on a single holder or mount it with others on a multi-place ribbon bar using clamps or screws for a secure and ordered presentation.

Q: Is the Ordine al Merito di Savoia a state honor of the Italian Republic?

A: No. The Ordine al Merito di Savoia is a dynastic/private order and is not recognized as a state honor by the Italian Republic.

Tip: Choose the variant (flat or Elite) that matches your existing medallist style and select the correct mounting option for neat alignment; also check related ribbon bars and mounting accessories to complete a professional, orderly presentation.
