## Product short description:

The Patch Alpiere Comando Truppe Alpine is an embroidered badge for Army personnel, designed to identify unit affiliation and role in alpine operations.

- **Material:** Embroidered on an olive-green background depicting an alpine eagle in black thread clutching an alpine hat feather, with a darkened five-point star in relief.
- **Use:** Reserved for Esercito personnel to indicate belonging and function within alpine units.
- **Placement:** Applied on Servizio e CBT uniforms, positioned above the "ESERCITO" name tape.
- **Size:** Compact and neat, measures 4 x 4 cm.

## Product overview

The Patch Alpiere Comando Truppe Alpine is an embroidered unit patch for the Italian Army's alpine command, designed for service and operational uniforms. It is aimed at Army personnel assigned to the Comando Truppe Alpine (COMTA) and qualified collectors who meet legal



requirements.

Definition: this is a compact embroidered insignia that identifies the “Alpiere” role within the Comando Truppe Alpine.

### **Main features**

Professional, low-profile design suitable for tactical and duty uniforms and military surplus collections.

- Black embroidered alpine eagle with wings spread.
- Eagle with open beak, facing its own left (as specified).
- Eagle clutching the traditional alpine hat feather (penna).
- Five-point browned star in relief over the eagle and feather.
- Olive green background consistent with uniform colors.
- Black embroidered perimeter border for clean stitching.
- Toothed Velcro backing for quick attachment; size 5 cm (L) × 4 cm (H).

### **How to use / When it's useful**

Quick answer: place the patch on the CBT camouflage uniform above the “ESERCITO” name tape, following unit regulations. The patch is made for operational/service wear and integrates with other front uniform elements.

In most cases, the patch is attached with Velcro where provided or sewn for a more permanent fit, depending on the unit's practice. It is useful for personnel who need an ordered, regulation-compliant insignia and for collectors who hold required authorization.

### **Care and notes**

Follow uniform and unit rules when fitting and caring for the patch; the product is built for service use but requires proper handling.

- If Velcro is used, check attachment regularly; sewing gives the most durable result when allowed by regulations.
- Clean the uniform following the garment's instructions; avoid aggressive cleaning methods on the patch.
- Sale and delivery are restricted: available to Army personnel after identity/service verification and to collectors with the required prefectural license (art. 28 TULPS).

### **FAQ**

**Q:** Is this patch reserved?



**A:** Yes. Sales are reserved to Army personnel and to collectors who can provide the required prefectoral license under art. 28 TULPS.

**Q:** What documents do military buyers need?

**A:** Military buyers must provide a copy of their ID card or a service certificate proving affiliation to the Army. Verification is completed before purchase is approved.

**Q:** What do collectors need to buy this patch?

**A:** Collectors must send a copy of the prefectoral license (ex art. 28 TULPS). The license is checked during the verification process.

**Q:** Where exactly is the patch worn?

**A:** The recommended placement is on the CBT camouflage uniform, positioned above the “ESERCITO” name tape, in accordance with unit rules.

**Q:** What are the patch dimensions?

**A:** The patch measures 5 cm (length) × 4 cm (height). The compact size keeps the uniform line neat and readable at close range.

**Q:** Is it better to sew or use Velcro?

**A:** Velcro is the most versatile option and allows quick removal; sewing is recommended where a permanent, stable fit is required by unit regulations.

**Tip:** Choose the correct placement and attachment method according to your unit’s rules, and check related alpine insignia (fregi, crests, berets) to complete a coherent uniform or collection without adding unauthorized reproductions.
