## Product short description:

The Humanitarian Relief Ribbon — Over 3 Missions (Nastrino Soccorso Umanitario Oltre 3 Missioni) honors individuals who have participated in more than three humanitarian missions. Ideal for service members, aid workers and supporters, it offers a respectful, wearable symbol of commitment and solidarity.

- **Material:** Made from quality fabric for a neat, durable finish.
- **Purpose:** Recognizes participation in over three humanitarian missions.
- **Wear:** Suitable to display on uniforms, jackets or civilian clothing.

## Product description:

### Product overview

The Nastrino Soccorso Umanitario Oltre 3 Missioni is a ribbon badge for personnel who have taken part in more than three humanitarian missions. It suits military, humanitarian workers, police and collectors who need an official-looking ribbon for uniform display or remembrance.

Definition: a commemorative ribbon featuring a silver five-point star on brown fabric with the Italian tricolour at the centre, established by interministerial decree on 27 November 1996. It is a



recognised emblem of service on duty in humanitarian operations.

### Main features

Designed for durability and correct uniform presentation, the ribbon is available in standard sizes and mounting options to suit different service and display needs.

- **Distinctive design:** silver five-point star on brown fabric with the Italian tricolour at the centre.
- **High-quality materials:** made with durable components for long-term wear and storage.
- **Sizes:** available in 37 mm and 20 mm to match standard ribbon bars.
- **Elite variant:** slightly domed version (Elite) for a different finish compared with the flat regulation style.
- **Mounting options:** supplied with a ribbon holder fitted with either a clip (morsetto) or screws, selectable at purchase.
- **Limited availability:** produced in restricted quantities due to demand and symbolic importance.

### How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use the ribbon on your uniform ribbon bar, multiple-ribbon holder, or as a single commemorative piece—choose the size that matches your existing ribbons. In most cases, the 37 mm format suits full-size ribbon bars and the 20 mm fits compact or dress arrangements.

Fit the ribbon to a ribbon holder using the selected clip or screws; when mounting multiple ribbons, arrange them according to your service regulations. This product is useful for active duty display, veteran recognition, ceremonial wear, and military surplus collections where accurate presentation matters.

### Care and notes

Keep the ribbon in good condition with simple care and correct mounting to preserve its appearance and symbolic value.

- Avoid prolonged exposure to moisture and harsh chemicals; store in a dry place.
- Select the correct size (37 mm or 20 mm) and mounting type before ordering to match your ribbon bar.
- Secure screws tightly if using the screw-mounted holder; check fittings periodically.
- Availability is limited—check stock and choose options carefully when adding to cart.

### FAQ

**Q:** What sizes are available for this ribbon?



**A:** The ribbon is available in two sizes: 37 mm and 20 mm. Choose the size that matches your existing ribbon bar or display requirements.

**Q:** What mounting options can I select?

**A:** You can order the ribbon with a ribbon holder fitted with either a clip (morsetto) or screws. Select your preferred mounting type from the product options before purchase.

**Q:** What is the Elite variant?

**A:** The Elite variant is a slightly domed (bombed) version of the ribbon, offering a different visual finish compared with the flat regulation style.

**Q:** When was this humanitarian service ribbon established?

**A:** The Nastrino Soccorso Umanitario was instituted by interministerial decree on 27 November 1996 and recognises participation in humanitarian missions.

**Q:** What materials are used to make the ribbon?

**A:** The ribbon is made with durable, high-quality materials designed for long-term wear and storage. Specific fabric details follow standard ribbon manufacturing practices.

**Q:** Can I order multiple ribbons on a multi-holder?

**A:** Yes. The ribbon can be supplied for multi-ribbon holders; choose the correct size and mounting option when ordering to ensure proper fit on your ribbon bar.

**Tip:** When ordering, confirm the correct size (37 mm or 20 mm) and mounting type (clip or screws). Consider the Elite domed finish if you prefer a slightly rounded appearance, and browse related ribbon and ribbon-holder items to complete your display or collection.
