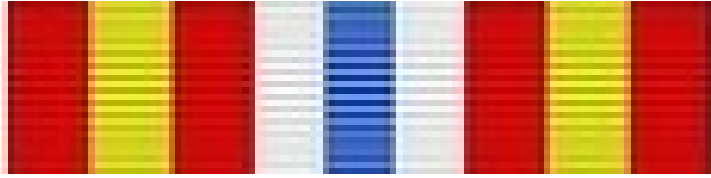

Product overview

The Nastrino Terremoto Irpinia 1980 is a commemorative ribbon created after the 1980 Irpinia earthquake, intended for collectors, memorial displays, museums and anyone wishing to honor victims and recovery efforts. It suits collectors of militaria, tactical and military surplus items, as well as civic and police remembrance displays.



Definition: the Nastrino Terremoto Irpinia 1980 is a government-issued commemorative ribbon established by ordinance n. 335 on 21 June 1981 to mark the earthquake and subsequent relief and reconstruction efforts.

Main features

Designed for display and collection, the ribbon is offered in several formats and mounting options to fit most medal bars and presentation needs.

- **Variants:** standard flat regulation style or a slightly domed "Elite" variant.
- **Sizes:** available in 37 mm and 20 mm widths, plus loose ribbon for large medals or reduced formats.
- **Mounting options:** supplied with a ribbon mount featuring a rear clamp or screw attachment for secure display.
- **Multi-place display:** can be mounted on two-slot or multi-slot metal ribbon bars for grouped presentations.
- **Commemorative origin:** established by the Commissario straordinario di Governo ordinance n. 335 (21 June 1981).

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use the ribbon for display on medal racks, memorial installations, museum exhibits or in private militaria collections. It is primarily a commemorative item rather than an operational duty insignia.

In most cases, collectors choose the size and variant that match their existing medal mounts or display preferences. Use the clamp or screws provided to fasten the ribbon securely to metal bases or presentation boards for stable, long-term display.

Care and notes

Keep the ribbon in good condition with simple care and the correct mounting choice.

- Store in a dry place away from direct sunlight to preserve colors and fabric.
- Handle with clean hands and attach using the supplied clamp or screws for secure display.
- Select the correct width (37 mm or 20 mm) to match your medal bar or presentation format.
- Availability may be limited; consider your preferred variant and size when ordering.

FAQ

Q: What sizes are available for the Nastrino Terremoto Irpinia 1980?

A: The ribbon is offered in 37 mm and 20 mm widths, plus options as loose ribbon for large medals or reduced formats. Choose the size that fits your medal bar or display.



Q: Can I have the ribbon mounted on a multi-place base?

A: Yes, the ribbon can be packaged on metal ribbon bars with two or more positions so you can create custom groupings or paired displays.

Q: What are the available variants of the ribbon?

A: You can choose the regulation flat format or the slightly domed "Elite" variant depending on your aesthetic preference and display style.

Q: How is the ribbon supplied for safe display?

A: It is available with a ribbon mount featuring a rear clamp or screw attachment, providing a secure and stable method to attach it to metal bases or presentation boards.

Q: Why purchase the Nastrino Terremoto Irpinia 1980?

A: Purchasing the ribbon supports remembrance of the 1980 Irpinia earthquake, honors victims and survivors, and helps preserve the memory of relief and reconstruction efforts in collections or commemorative displays.

Q: What is the official origin of this ribbon?

A: The Nastrino Terremoto Irpinia 1980 was instituted by ordinance of the Commissario straordinario di Governo on 21 June 1981, n. 335, as a commemorative emblem following the earthquake.

Tip: Choose the correct width and variant to match your medal bar or display; consider a multi-place metal ribbon bar if you plan to group ribbons. Browse related commemorative and militaria items to complete your collection or memorial setup.
