Definition: the MA-1 is a nylon flight jacket with a high-visibility orange polyester lining originally designed for pilots. Built from durable materials with practical pockets and elasticated ribbing, it is made for year-round use in mild to cool conditions.

## Main features

Key construction and functional details:

- **Shell:** 100% nylon for durability and light weather protection.
- **Lining:** 100% polyester high-visibility orange inner lining for emergency visibility.
- **Shoulder pocket:** Left sleeve zip pocket with integrated pen holder.
- **Front pockets:** Two lower pockets secured with metal snap buttons.
- **Fit details:** Elasticated ribbed collar, cuffs and waistband for a snug, wind-resistant fit.
- **Weather resistance:** Water-resistant surface suitable for light rain and wind.

## How to use / When it's useful

Use this MA-1 as a mid-layer or outer shell in spring, autumn and cool winter days. It performs well for everyday urban wear, light outdoor tasks and roles that need a tactical or military look without heavy insulation. Quick answer: it protects from wind and light rain but is not intended for heavy downpours.

In most cases, choose your usual jacket size for a regular fit; size up if you plan to wear thick layers underneath. The jacket is also a good base for adding patches or embroidery to match duty, police or military-surplus styling.

## Care and notes

Basic care and important notes to preserve the jacket:

- Check and follow the garment care label for specific washing instructions.
- Wash gently in cold water and line dry to protect the shell and lining.
- Avoid bleach and high-heat drying; do not iron directly on patches or printed areas.
- Not fully waterproof — avoid prolonged exposure to heavy rain.
- Remove or secure loose patches before washing if possible.

## FAQ

**Q:** Is the MA-1 bomber jacket waterproof?

**A:** No, it is not fully waterproof. The 100% nylon shell is water-resistant and sheds light rain and



wind, but it is not designed for heavy or prolonged downpours.

**Q:** Can I personalize the jacket with patches or embroidery?

**A:** Yes. Tutto Militare offers customization options for patches and embroidery on request so you can add unit-style insignia, logos or personal designs.

**Q:** What sizes are available for the MA-1?

**A:** The jacket is offered in multiple sizes. Consult the store's size guide to find the best fit, especially if you plan to layer clothing underneath.

**Q:** What materials make up the jacket?

**A:** The outer shell is 100% nylon and the inner lining is 100% polyester in high-visibility orange, a feature originating from pilot flight gear for emergency visibility.

**Q:** What is the origin or history of the MA-1?

**A:** The MA-1 originated as a U.S. military flight jacket in the 1950s. Early versions followed military specifications (MIL-SPEC) and the design later moved into civilian fashion with the same functional features.

**Q:** How should I care for the jacket to keep it in good condition?

**A:** Follow the garment label: gentle washing in cold water and line drying are recommended. Avoid high heat and do not iron directly over patches or the orange lining.
