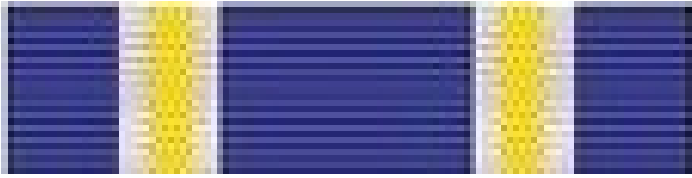

The Nastrino Art. 5 NATO Active Endeavour dal 2011 is a service ribbon for personnel who took part in NATO maritime security missions in the Mediterranean since 2011. Suitable for military personnel, uniform displays, and collectors seeking an authentic commemorative ribbon.

- **Material:** Made from quality ribbon fabric with a durable finish.
- **Use:** Intended as a uniform ribbon or keepsake to acknowledge service in Active Endeavour.

Product overview

The nastrino Art. 5 NATO Active Endeavour dal 2011 is a service ribbon intended for personnel, veterans, and collectors related to the NATO Active Endeavour mission. Definition: this is the campaign ribbon bearing the revised 2011 graphic design for that mission.



This ribbon is made from durable materials and offered in the standard 37 mm width. It suits duty uniforms, display racks, military surplus stores, and personal collections; stock is limited and demand can be high.

Main features

Key details and options for the nastrino Art. 5 NATO Active Endeavour dal 2011:

- **Updated graphic design:** Revised 2011 artwork that identifies the Active Endeavour mission.
- **Available formats:** Regulation (standard) or flat format, plus a slightly domed "Elite" variant.
- **Accessories:** Option to include a single-place ribbon mount with clamp or screw fastenings selectable at purchase.
- **Standard size:** Supplied only in the 37 mm width to match common service ribbon dimensions.
- **Loose ribbon option:** Can be purchased as a loose ribbon for custom mounting or display.
- **Durable construction:** Made for long-term wear and display with attention to finish and detail.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: wear the nastrino on the uniform where campaign ribbons are placed, mount it on a single ribbon bar, or keep it as a collector's item. It is useful for personnel who served in the mission, for ceremonial presentation, or for resale in tactical and military surplus shops.

In most cases, choose the regulation format for official or formal wear and the flat or Elite variant for a slimmer or slightly domed appearance on display mounts. If you need a different mounting setup, buy the loose ribbon and assemble it with your preferred portanastrini (ribbon bar).

Care and notes

Basic care and practical notes to keep the ribbon in good condition:

- Store away from prolonged sunlight and moisture to preserve colors and fabric.
- Clean gently with a soft, dry cloth; avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaning.
- Check fastenings (clamps or screws) regularly to ensure secure mounting on the ribbon bar.
- Available only in the mission's official design and colors; no other color variants are offered.
- Limited stock: consider ordering early if you need a specific format or mounting option.

FAQ

Q: What is the difference between the regulation and flat format?



A: The regulation format follows the standard ribbon shape used for uniforms, while the flat format is thinner and more discreet for display or reduced-profile mounting.

Q: Can I buy the ribbon without the ribbon mount?

A: Yes. Select the loose ribbon option to purchase the nastrino alone for custom mounting or personal display projects.

Q: What are the ribbon dimensions?

A: The nastrino is available only in the 37 mm width, which matches common service ribbon dimensions used for mounting on ribbon bars.

Q: Are other color versions available?

A: No. This nastrino is produced only in the official design and colors associated with the NATO Active Endeavour mission from 2011.

Q: How do I mount this ribbon on a multi-place ribbon bar?

A: For multi-place mounting, use a compatible metal ribbon bar sized for multiple ribbons and arrange the nastrino alongside others; choose the clamp or screw fastenings during purchase for a secure fit.

Q: Is this ribbon appropriate for official uniform wear?

A: The ribbon follows common size conventions and the mission design, but for official wear approval always confirm with your unit or relevant authority before wearing on formal uniforms.

Tip: When ordering, choose the format (regulation, flat, or Elite) and mounting option that match your intended use—uniform wear, display rack, or collection—and check related ribbons or mounts to complete your set.
