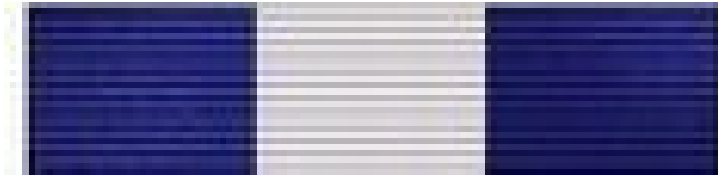

The Nastrino Lunga Navigazione Marittima is a historic naval ribbon awarded to seafarers for extended maritime service, suitable for veterans, merchant mariners, collectors, and uniform displays. It is offered in multiple classes and sizes to match official wear and personal preference.

Definition: a service ribbon originally established in 1904 to recognize long navigation at sea.



Ideal for military surplus sellers, tactical collectors, and duty uniform restorations.

Main features

Authentic-looking ribbon available in different classes, formats, and mounting options to suit display, replacement, or presentation needs.

- **Historic origin:** Instituted by royal decree on 27 November 1904 and updated into three classes in 1945.
- **Three classes:** Gold, silver, and bronze options to reflect different levels of recognition.
- **Two sizes:** Available in 37 mm and 20 mm formats to fit standard ribbon bars.
- **Two finishes:** Regulatory flat format or slightly domed "Elite" variant for a refined look.

How to use / When it's useful

Quick answer: use this nastrino as a replacement ribbon, a display piece, or part of a service uniform where appropriate. It suits collectors, re-enactors, and personnel maintaining period-correct uniforms.

In most cases, select the class, size (37 mm or 20 mm), and mounting style that match your existing ribbons or uniform regulations. Choose the Elite slightly domed finish for a more pronounced appearance or the flat regulatory format for official conformity.

Care and notes

Basic care and selection tips to keep the ribbon neat and compliant with uniform standards.

- Check official uniform rules before wearing on active or ceremonial uniforms.
- Select the correct size (37 mm or 20 mm) to match your ribbon bar spacing.
- Choose clamp or screw mounting based on how you will attach it to the bar.
- Store in a dry place; avoid strong solvents or abrasive cleaning that could damage the ribbon finish.

FAQ

Q: Which classes are available for the Nastrino Lunga Navigazione Marittima?

A: The ribbon is offered in three classes: gold, silver, and bronze. Choose the class that corresponds to the recognition level you need.



Q: What sizes does the ribbon come in?

A: It is available in two standard sizes: 37 mm and 20 mm. Pick the size that fits your ribbon bar or display.

Q: Can I buy the ribbon with a mounting bar (portanastrino)?

A: Yes. You can select a portanastrino with a rear clamp attachment or with screws, depending on your preference and mounting method.

Q: What is the "Elite" variant?

A: The Elite variant is a slightly domed (convex) finish compared with the flat regulatory format, offering a more pronounced appearance while preserving the ribbon's original design.

Q: Can the ribbon be mounted on a multi-place ribbon bar?

A: Yes. The ribbon can be fitted on multi-place metal bases designed to hold two or more ribbons joined together on a single bar.

Q: Is this ribbon historically accurate?

A: The nastrino traces its origins to the 1904 royal decree and was reformed in 1945; the product reflects those historic classes and presentation styles for display and replacement use.

Tip: Choose the correct class and size for your uniform or display, and consider the Elite or flat finish to match existing ribbons; browse related ribbon bars and mounting options to complete your set.
