The Green Paracord 550 Type III is a lightweight, high-strength nylon cord designed for outdoor users, campers, hunters, paddlers, bushcrafters and those sourcing tactical or military surplus gear. It is also suitable as a general-purpose utility cord for police duty and emergency kits.

Definition: Paracord 550 Type III is a 4 mm, 100% nylon cord with a 32-carrier outer sheath and a 7-strand inner core, with an indicative breaking load of about 250 kg. It combines strength,



flexibility and compact storage for everyday outdoor and tactical use.

Main features

Reliable construction and compact size make this paracord a practical addition to any kit.

- Diameter: 4 mm — compact and easy to handle.
- Material: 100% nylon for a balance of strength and light weight.
- Construction: 32-carrier outer sheath with 7 twisted inner strands for durability and flexibility.
- Indicative breaking load: approximately 250 kg (for general guidance).
- Lightweight and packable — rolls small for backpacks and duty belts.
- Versatile for camping, trekking, canoeing, bushcraft, tactical and police utility tasks.

How to use / When it's useful

Use the paracord for guy lines, gear lashings, improvised shelter, repairing equipment, or as utility cord in camp and fieldwork. Quick answer: use it for shelter lines, straps, small hoists and general repairs—where a strong, flexible cord is needed.

In most cases, Paracord 550 handles routine outdoor and tactical tasks reliably, but it should not replace certified life-safety or climbing ropes. Keep spare lengths in your pack or duty bag for emergency repairs and field improvisation.

Care and notes

Simple care extends cord life and keeps performance predictable. Follow these practical notes when using and storing the cord:

- Inspect regularly for cuts, abrasion or melted sections and replace if damaged.
- Clean with mild soap and water; air dry away from direct heat or sunlight.
- Do not exceed the indicative breaking load (~250 kg); avoid using as primary life-safety or climbing rope.
- Store in a cool, dry place to prevent mildew and UV degradation.

FAQ

Q: What is the breaking load of the Green Paracord 550 Type III?

A: The indicative breaking load is about 250 kg. This value is for general guidance; actual performance depends on knots, wear and condition.

Q: What material is the paracord made from?



A: It is made from 100% nylon, offering a good balance of strength, flexibility and resistance to abrasion.

Q: What is the cord diameter?

A: The diameter is 4 mm, making it compact and easy to handle for packing, lashing and general utility tasks.

Q: How is the paracord constructed?

A: The cord features a 32-carrier outer sheath and an inner core of 7 twisted strands, which together provide durability and flexibility.

Q: Can I use this paracord for climbing or rescue?

A: No. While strong for general utility, it should not replace certified climbing or life-safety ropes. Use it for gear, shelter and non-life-critical tasks.

Q: Is this suitable for tactical, police or military use?

A: Yes. It is commonly used in tactical, police and military surplus kits for utility tasks, repairs and field improvisation, though not for life-safety applications.
